MUSINGS OF FATHER JIM: Dear Family of God,

"The observances of National Marriage Week (Feb. 7-14) and World Marriage Day (Sunday, Feb. 12) are an opportunity to focus on building a culture of life and love that begins with supporting and promoting marriage and the family. This year's theme, "Marriage...one flesh, given and received" highlights the one-flesh union of husband and wife that is willed by God. It also indicates the personal self-gift of each spouse, one to the other. These concepts point to Christ who gives Himself under the appearance of bread and wine—as real flesh and blood."

I was graced to preside at a nuptial mass for a young man and his young bride last Saturday, whom I had pastored for 15 years of his childhood in St. Alphonsus parish of Satanta. The vows were made before the altar of the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Wichita in the shadow of the tomb of blessed Fr. Emil Kapaun. It has been too long since I have served a wedding where all of the groomsman were in communion with the Church and the couple in their celebration of their vows. It was an astounding witness of the beauty and sanctity of the vows of matrimony and the call to the communion of love.

The Church calls this act of faith, the Sacrament of Matrimony. The Word and concept of marriage has become so diffused and misappropriated that it has been seriously weakened in our time. I cherish the word matrimony because it highlights the protection of motherhood. I heard a well-known exorcist of the church say that all the sexual dysphoria and sexual liberality of our age is a direct attack of the evil one upon motherhood. I had never thought of the attack on marriage in that light.

The theme of "one flesh given and received" brings into full light the sacramentality of matrimony entered with full commitment and prayer. The union of man and woman is a sacred act of the Church in faith to receive new life and preserve it for eternity. The sacrament is for the salvation of souls, though marriage is only until "death do us part". This is something willed by God, but profaned by sin, by the misguided will of those who refuse to glorify God with their lives of faith. So, it was great joy to see such beautiful entrance into a life commitment of love ordained to the family. They are our hope for the future.

Valentine's Day has been reduced to the glorification of erotic love. The sacrament of matrimony stands as the witness to the eternal love of God and his will for his people. I am a romantic and relish Valentine's Day that does promote acts of affective love, but know that without the redemption of fidelity and lifelong commitment, these acts are like the passing wind when what is needed is a holy sanctuary of an eternal dwelling in and through Jesus Christ. I give thanks for all those witnessing in the sacrament of Holy Matrimony and pray for those who have suffered the pain of broken families . Fr. Jim
