MUSINGS FROM FATHER JIM: Dear faithful,

Thank you to all who participated in the celebration of Corpus Christi and the Eucharistic procession and welcomed my family to the wonderful banquet of potluck that we shared at St. Anthony of Padua in Fowler last Sunday afternoon. Particularly, thanks to Jan Brock, Greg Bradford, and Pam Milford for the beautiful music. I know it came at some sacrifice of family time to gather out of the ordinary Mass schedule, but it was a glorious celebration of the Paschal Mystery and special thanks too, to all who worked so hard to prepare the School Building and serve the Potluck. Blessings!

Today is Flag Day. It is one of those days that slips up on the ordinary citizen, like myself, and at the last minute, I drag out the flag and fly it. It is "a Grand Old Flag, a high flying flag..." worthy of displaying. The holiday is somewhat like the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, on the Roman Calendar, the First Friday after the Feast of Corpus Christi. It is easy to miss, though it holds great meaning and importance to our faith. The Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is a late devotion, only arising in the Church in the 1800s, but very popular because of its great mystical significance to entering and understanding the paschal mystery of the sacrifice of the Mass, and the Divine Love poured out from the person of Jesus of Nazareth.

Our old Cathedral in Dodge City was dedicated to the Sacred Heart and the daily chapel in the new cathedral is so dedicated. We have two other parishes in our diocese dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, Pratt and Larned. The devotion needs to be lifted high. We add the Litany to the Sacred Heart at the First Friday Mass celebrated at 7:30 PM at Fowler each month. That was the inspiration for scheduling the "extra" Mass for the Solemnity at 7:30 PM on Friday.

I apologize for the misinformation in the bulletin this week, the cost of having an annual retreat. I am posting here the Mass intentions offered at the daily Masses this past week, that were inadvertently omitted in scheduling the Prayer and Action a week early. The National Eucharistic Revival has developed "Jesus and the Eucharist," a small group study for use during the Year of Parish Revival. It will be provided free of charge. This seven-session study begins with the kerygmatic proclamation (Sessions 1-4) and builds to God's saving work in the Eucharist (Sessions 5-7). Drawing from lesson content created by the Augustine Institute (formed.org), the Revival team has expanded the study to include an opening message from a different (arch)bishop followed by lectio divina prayer with Scripture. Lessons include testimonies from Catholics across the country, which then transition into small group discussions. Each session is two hours or less in duration with an emphasis on participant engagement. There is no information yet from the National Eucharistic Revival team on how to access these videos or when they will be available. Watch the bulletin for when this becomes available and group opportunities to participate.
