MUSINGS FROM FATHER JIM:

Dear parents, grandparents, and all others involved with catechism

I am so grateful to those who have stepped forward to provide catechism for our youth. The painful perennial question that arises, "Where are they for Sunday Mass?", is a worrisome reality. Anyone who has worked in this mission knows that all the efforts to share the faith are futile without the first faith witness of the home. Many parishes without parochial schools have tried to implement family based catechesis, realizing that this is the more effective transmission of the faith to the next generation. In short, without the parent's faithful participation, there will be little chance that the children will become participating adults.

I am attempting to make available family catechesis in conjunction with the National Eucharistic Revival. In collaboration with the Augustine Institute in Colorado who provides the FORMED format internationally, the national committee is providing this premier adult formation in the participation in the real presence of our Lord in the Eucharist in a seven video series, Jesus and the Eucharist. I have established the plan to provide the weekly video following the 5:30 PM Mass in Plains, at 4:00 PM on Sunday afternoon at the Forst Center in Meade, and in the school at Fowler on Thursday evening at 7:00 PM. All are welcome!

On Sunday, September 17th, we celebrate Catechetical Sunday. The theme is appropriately, "Come to me all you who labor and are burdened" Matthew 11:28. I will be offering a blessing for all of the Catechists present at the Sunday Masses. Please join in praying for them, but even more by supporting them with your practice of the faith. Blessings, Fr.
