St. John XXIII

Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli was born to a poor farming family in Bergamo, Italy. His ordination as a priest in 1904 began a lifetime serving the Church as: the bishop's secretary, a military chaplain, cardinal-patriarch of Venice, and finally, as pope. Even so, St. John never forgot his humble origins, and he was known for visiting the poor, the sick and prisoners. As pope, he is most remembered for opening the Second Vatican Council. He died in 1963.

San Juan XXIII

Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli nació en una familia pobre de Bérgamo, en Italia. Al ser ordenado sacerdote en 1904 inició una vida de servicio a la Iglesia: como secretario episcopal, como capellán militar, como cardenal patriarca de Venecia y finalmente como papa. Con todo, san Juan jamás olvidó sus orígenes humildes y fue conocido por sus visitas a los pobres, los enfermos y los encarcelados. Como papa se le recuerda especialmente por inaugurar el Concilio Vaticano Segundo. Murió en 1963.

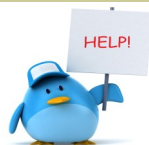
