Dear Parishioners,

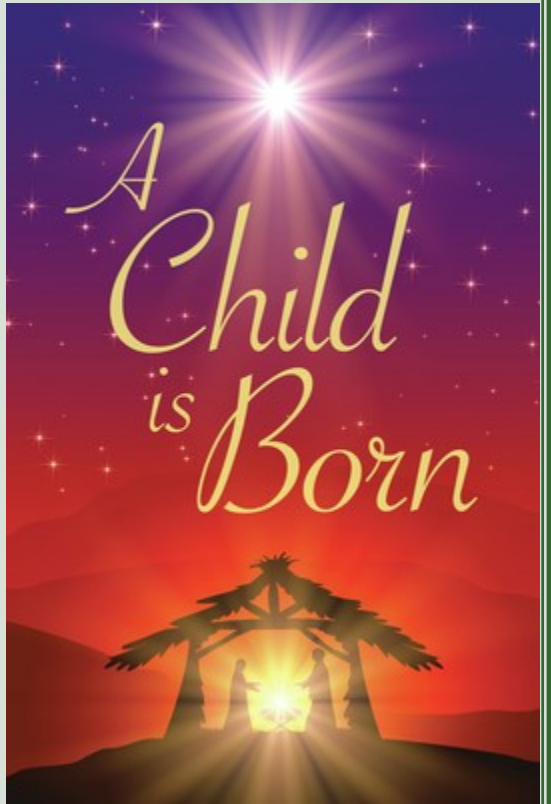
