VOCATION SPOTLIGHT



MS. SAVANNAH SULLY

Hello, for those who don't know me, my name is Savannah Sully. I am 26 years old, from Silverton, Oregon, and was raised in the faith at St. Paul's. I was involved with the children's choir, youth group, and received my Confirmation here. After graduating from Oregon State University in 2017 I served for 2 years as a volunteer missionary (which was possible with the generous support of many of you) with OSU's Newman Center and American University in DC. During those years I experienced a growing desire to give my life to serving the Lord and become completely His. After 2 years of discernment, I believe the Lord is calling me to give my life totally to Him through the vocation of consecrated life. I have been discerning specifically with the Society of Mary, an order of missionary sisters dedicated to announcing the message of Christ. They work with the brother society of missionary priests) to provide many activities and programs to bring people to, or back to, the Faith and encounter a new life in Christ. I met the Societies when I attended OSU and began getting involved in the Newman Center, which is the Catholic Campus Ministry at OSU. The Priests and Sisters that served there helped me grow significantly in my faith.

Growing up Catholic, I knew God called some men and women to a different kind of life as Priests, Brothers, or Sisters. For a long time I was afraid that God would ask this of me. When I thought of what it would be like to be a religious sister, I could only picture the nuns I had seen in movies. To me, it seemed like a lonely and boring life filled with many sacrifices. But now, God has replaced my fear with excitement and I now see this life as one filled with joy, peace, adventure, community, and the deep love of God. I will be entering the Society of Mary on August 15th with 4 other young women to begin formation. We will be living at our Pastoral Center in West Linn, OR.

The other reason I am writing to you is because there is one thing I must do before entering and that is to be free of debt. I am working towards paying off the remainder of my student loans (\$22,000) by August. It is a daunting task but I am confident that God will make a way so I can be truly free for this great mission. Therefore, I am humbly asking for financial partners to support me. I would be honored to have my home parish join me in this mission. Please take some time to pray and see if you feel called to support me. Please let me know if you have any questions, I am happy to speak more with you about this mission! I am also in need of spiritual support and your prayers are greatly appreciated in this time!



ST. BRIDGET OF SWEDEN | FEAST DAY: JULY 23

Bridget or Birgitta was born in 1303, the daughter of Birger Petersson, governor of Uppland and his wife Ingeborg Bengtsdotter. She was married to Ulf Gudmarsson, who became governor of the province of Nericia. They had eight children, all of whom survived past infancy which was rare for the 12th century. One of their daughters would become St. Catherine of Sweden. Saint Bridget was hailed as a mystic and her visions, which began in her early childhood when she had visions of Christ Crucified, made her somewhat of a Middle Ages celebrity. Her vision of the Nativity of Jesus even influenced the art of the Nativity through the Baroque era! She is said to have predicted the Vatican State. Saint Bridget's Revelations, which she dictated to Peter Olafsson, the prior at the Cistercian monastery of Alvastra near which she retired after her husband's death in 1344, were published in 1492. They have since been published in many languages and can still be purchased today. Some of her most profound visions regarded the founding of a new religious order which would be primarily for women, ruled by an abbess, but with a separate house for monks who would serve as order chaplains. Her visions detailed everything from the abbey church to the clothing that would be adopted as the nun's habit, and how the order would be ruled. King Magnus II of Sweden granted Bridget land and buildings. The order, called the Bridgettines or the Order of the Most Holy Savior was approved by Pope Urban V in 1370. Saint Bridget was canonized in 1391 by Pope Boniface IX and in 1999 Pope John Paul II named her one of the Patron Saints of Europe.

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP

Be Ready for God to Stop By

In my experience, most people can be divided into two groups: those who are old enough to remember when you kept food on hand for company, and those who aren't.

For those of you in the latter group, let me explain. Before text messaging and social media made us all unconditionally, mercilessly reachable, people would do this thing called "stopping by." They would be passing by a friend's house, maybe on the way home from work or shopping, and they would just ... stop. With no warning. No notice whatsoever. "I was just in the neighborhood," they would say. I remember my mother and I would do this on many a Saturday. It wasn't an everyday occurrence, but it was common enough that you had to be ready.

"Crazy," you might exclaim. "People just appeared on your doorstep? How did you cope with the uncertainty?" Well, most of us had moms who kept a little something on hand to eat or drink that was extra nice, just in case anyone stopped by. That way, we were always ready.

Today's readings are about a lot of things: prayer, hope, redemptive suffering. They're about what it means to be a Christian, and not just what it means to do Christian things. Most of all, though, they're about readiness. If God showed up at your door, would you be ready for Him? Would you be ready for what He gives you, or what He takes away? Would you be ready for Him to interrupt the plans you have for yourself? To disrupt the idea you carry in your mind of what a servant or a steward is supposed to be?

Read your Bible. Say your rosary. Go to Mass. Get to Confession. Talk to God — every day, not just when you think you need Him. That way, you are always ready.
