Reflecting Deeper on **THE GOSPEL**

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

6th Sunday in Ordinary Time

It's often said that the Catholic Church lays heavy rules on her members, rules that can almost seem impossible. Mass every Sunday? No lying ever? Sexual purity all the time? I recently said to some non-Catholic friends that more than fifty adults were baptized at my parish at the Easter Vigil. One responded spontaneously with shock, "Why would anyone do that?" In other words, why would someone willingly place themselves in a system with such demanding and rigorous rules?

Of course, no one in the history of religions is more demanding and rigorous than Jesus himself. In the Sermon on the Mount, he says you have to be holier than pharisees or you're out. He says if you call someone a fool, you go to fiery Gehenna. He says you can't even look at a woman with lust or you're guilty of adultery (which was punishable by death). To top it all off, he says you can't even get divorced and re-married. Doesn't he know these are basically impossible demands? What world is he living in?

The new one, actually. He is the new world. Jesus' words aren't meant to condemn. They are meant to signal something new, a restored humanity. Jesus doesn't just give external laws; he gives us his Holy Spirit to internalize the law through love. He wants to fill us with his love. That's what the Church exists to do. Love demands extraordinary things. The "demands" of the Church only make sense because she is filled with Jesus' love. That wildly demanding love is why we are Catholic.—

Reflexión sobre **El Evangelio**

Alentando un Entendimiento Más Profundo de la Escritura

6° Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Ser creyente y buen cristiano supone tomar partido conforme a lo que creemos. Lo uno o lo otro, sin medias tintas. Desde tiempos antiguos existía la división. Las discusiones y habladuría sin fundamento ni compromiso, estaban y están a la orden del día. Para tomar partido de alguna decisión importante es necesario sintonizarse con la sabiduría de Dios. Solo así, sabremos gozar de la libertad que él ofrece desde siempre. Sin embargo, muchas veces estamos amenazados por esa belleza de escoger lo mejor para cada uno de nosotros. El plan de salvación de Dios es siempre actual y el ser humano pone en juego su fidelidad a Dios y a lo que cree.

La Primera Lectura ayuda grandemente para clarificar el pensamiento y disponer el corazón a la Palabra iluminadora de Dios: "Si tú quieres, puedes observar los mandamientos; está en tus manos el ser fiel. Ante ti puso el fuego y el agua: extiende la mano a lo que prefieras. Delante de los hombres están la vida y la muerte, a cada uno se le dará lo que ha elegido" (Sirácides 15,15-17). Significa que somos responsables de nuestros propios actos. Los actos de culto no están ajenos de los actos de justicia por una sociedad mejor. Deseo que, en esta Eucaristía, descubramos la sabiduría de Dios que tanto necesitamos, que no cerremos nuestro corazón a lo que ya sabemos, sino que descubramos los nuevos horizontes de Jesús en sus enseñanzas. ¡Así sea!

The Don't Live a Lie

One day, my son was explaining to his mother that he felt she had lied to him. It was nothing very important, but he wanted to take this opportunity to share how important telling the truth is to him. He explained that he simply tells it like it is in all aspects of his life. But an hour later, we caught him in a lie! Again, it was not about a matter of life and death, but it was a lie. When confronted with his own previous words on how important the telling the truth was to him, he just smiled. Yes, the guilty often have no words of defense.

Jesus said it best in Matthew 5: "Let your 'yes' mean 'yes' and your 'no' mean 'no'." He was warning his disciples about false oaths and then instructing them on the fullness of the Hebrew laws. We may try to do what we say and say what we mean, but it can be all too easy to fall short. We call ourselves disciples yet provide evidence to the contrary by our actions (or lack of them).

Even if we feel that we have lied to no one, we may have lied to ourselves. We portray ourselves as generous, thankful, and loving people, yet fail to answer God's call in a situation because we perceive the cost to be too great. Jesus did not simply mean for his message to be about two words. He also meant that when you say you are a disciple, make sure you are a disciple as well.

No vivir una mentira

Un día, mi hijo le estaba explicando a su madre que sentía que le había mentado. No era nada muy importante, pero quiso aprovechar la ocasión para compartir lo importante que es para él decir la verdad. Explicó que simplemente dice las cosas como son en todos los aspectos de su vida. Pero una hora más tarde, ¡le pillamos mintiendo! Una vez más, no se trataba de una cuestión de vida o muerte, pero era una mentira. Al confrontarle con sus propias palabras anteriores sobre lo importante que era para él decir la verdad, se limitó a sonreír. Sí, los culpables a menudo no tienen palabras de defensa.

Jesús lo dijo mejor en Mateo 5: "Que vuestro 'sí' signifique 'sí' y vuestro 'no' signifique 'no'". Estaba advirtiéndoles a sus discípulos sobre los falsos juramentos y luego instruyéndoles sobre la plenitud de las leyes hebreas. Puede que intentemos hacer lo que decimos y decir lo que queremos decir, pero es muy fácil que nos quedemos cortos. Nos llamamos a nosotros mismos discípulos, pero nuestras acciones (o la falta de ellas) demuestran lo contrario.

Aunque creamos que no hemos mentado a nadie, puede que nos hayamos mentado a nosotros mismos. Nos presentamos como personas generosas, agradecidas y cariñosas, pero no respondemos a la llamada de Dios en una situación porque consideramos que el costo es demasiado alto. Jesús no quería que su mensaje se limitara a dos palabras. También quiso decir que cuando digas que eres un discípulo, asegúrate de serlo tú también.

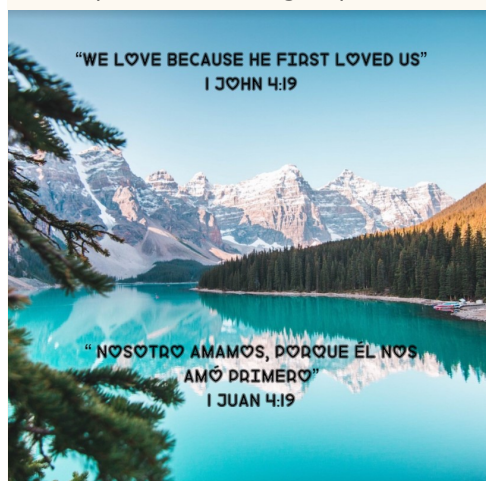

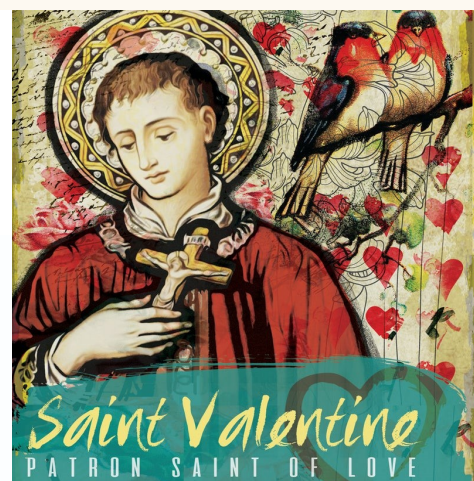

SACRAMENTOS CLASES PREMATRIMONIALES

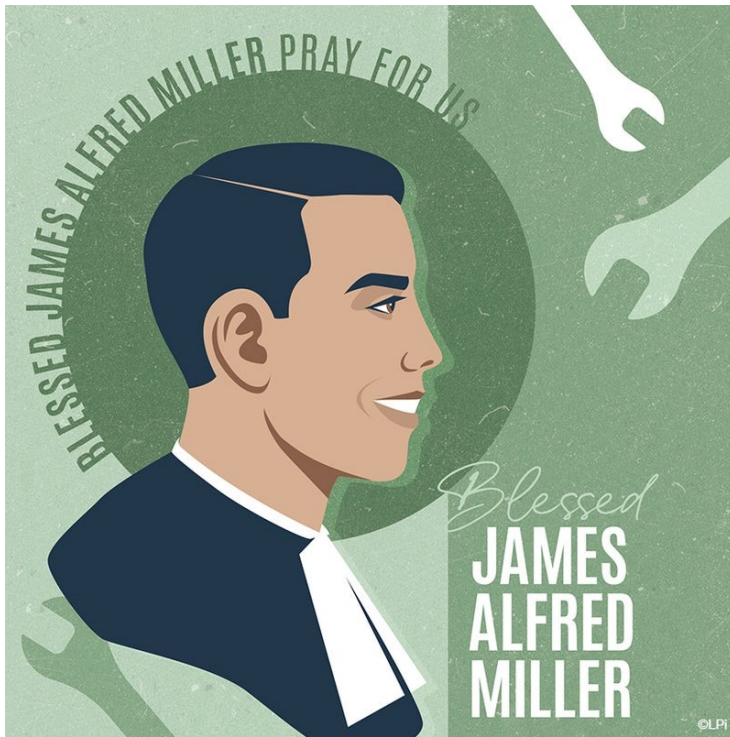

Blessed James Miller, the second ever U.S.-born martyr, served as a missionary and educator to the poorest of the poor in Nicaragua and Guatemala. Shot to death in front of his students in 1982, his legacy of love lives on today through the many schools he started.
