Reflecting Deeper on **THE GOSPEL**

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord

What's your car? Let's say it's a fancy silver Toyota. Now imagine you're having lunch in a restaurant and suddenly see two men outside attempting to steal it. You run outside and confront them. They respond, "The master has need of it." How do you respond? Would you just let them take it, and leave you without a car? I don't think I would.

Yet that is precisely what the owners of the colt on Palm Sunday do. Stunningly, and perhaps a little comically, Jesus instructs two of his disciples to commandeer a colt for him to ride. And when they hear the disciples say, "The master has need of it," they let them take it. Of course, Jesus knew they'd let it go. He gave them the grace to let go of what is rightfully theirs. The result? That colt became perhaps the most famous and important animal ever. The beast plays a role in the redemption of the world.

As Holy Week begins, Jesus perhaps will send people to you to ask for something valuable to you. Perhaps it's your car. More likely it's something like your attention, time, or energy. It's natural to resist at first. We've got things to do, after all. But if the interruption is from Jesus himself, listen to that voice which calmly says, "The master has need of it." And simply let it go. You'll be amazed what the master will do with it

Reflexión sobre **El Evangelio**

Alentando un Entendimiento Más Profundo de la Escritura

Domingo de Ramos de la Pasión de Cristo

Hoy empezamos la Semana Santa o Semana Mayor. Las lecturas de la liturgia de hoy nos presentan la entrada solemne de Jesús a Jerusalén y el relato de su Pasión. Las lecturas invitan realmente a entrar con Jesús a la ciudad y hacer de estos importantes días verdaderamente santos. Su entrada triunfal es de júbilo y paz, no de guerra y violencia. Montado en un burrito, no sobre un caballo de ejército. "Los discípulos se fueron e hicieron como Jesús les había mandado. Le trajeron la burra con su cría, le colocaron sus mantos sobre el lomo y él se sentó encima" (Mateo 21,6-7). La gente gritaba y se apretujaba por seguirlo. "¡Hosana al hijo de David! ¡Bendito sea el que viene en el nombre del Señor! ¡Hosana en lo más alto de los cielos!" (Mateo 21,9).

¿Quiénes de todos los que ahora lo alaban, gritarán en su contra el Viernes Santo? ¿Cuántos en la actualidad se avergüenzan de seguir y pertenecer a Jesús? La fe es para manifestarse en público y en privado. Se está con Jesús en momentos de júbilo y en momentos de su Pasión. Así es el ejemplo de este Domingo de Ramos, al principio de la Eucaristía se proclama el Evangelio de la entrada triunfante de Jesús a la ciudad y enseguida se proclama la Pasión del Señor. Triunfo y sufrimiento, júbilo y dolor, así es la existencia humana. Nuestra tarea en esta Semana Santa, es reflexionar en cuantas personas crucificadas están a nuestro alrededor. Y a la vez llevar a ellas la esperanza de la Pascua que ya viene.

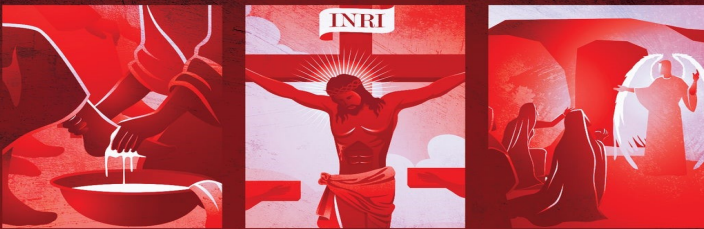

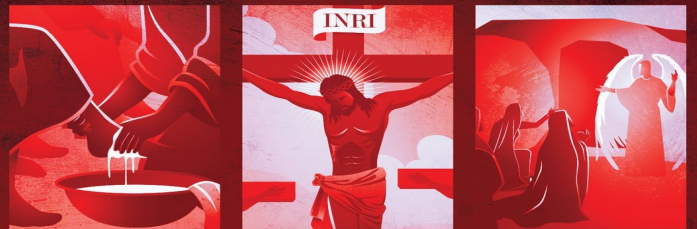

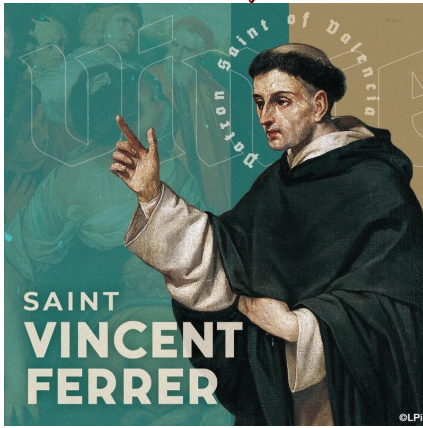

OUR SAINT *of the* WEEK



Sometimes it can be easy to idealize past ages in the Church. But a look at history shows that the Bride of Christ has never had it easy! In the days of St. Vincent Ferrer, two, then three men claimed to be the legitimate pope. Vincent found himself swept up in the drama. One of his old friends was elected a false pope. While initially supportive, Vincent became disillusioned by the division in the Church. He spent 20 years going back to the basics. He avoided Church politics and traveled Europe as a missionary preacher. Eventually, St. Vincent publicly denounced the man who had once been his friend. Sometimes drama, scandal, and disappointment in the Church can drive us away from our faith. Rather than leave, Vincent clung to Christ. During tumultuous times in the Church, St. Vincent Ferrer, pray for us!

A veces resulta fácil idealizar las épocas pasadas de la Iglesia. Pero una mirada a la historia muestra que la Esposa de Cristo nunca lo ha tenido fácil. En los días de San Vicente Ferrer, dos y luego tres hombres pretendieron ser el Papa legítimo. Vicente se vio envuelto en el drama. Uno de sus viejos amigos fue elegido falso Papa. Aunque al principio lo apoyó, Vicente se desilusionó con la división de la Iglesia. Pasó 20 años volviendo a lo básico. Evitó la política eclesiástica y viajó por Europa como predicador misionero. Finalmente, San Vicente denunció públicamente al que había sido su amigo. A veces, el drama, el escándalo y la decepción en la Iglesia pueden alejarnos de nuestra fe. En lugar de abandonar, Vicente se aferró a Cristo. En tiempos tumultuosos en la Iglesia, San Vicente Ferrer, ¡ruega por nosotros!
