Reflecting Deeper on **THE GOSPEL**

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

2nd Sunday of Easter (Sunday of Divine Mercy)

A young, engaged couple sat on the couch in front of me as we chatted about their upcoming marriage. The young lady was struggling to trust her future husband. She told me her father had been unfaithful to her mother. She said of her fiancé, “I want him to prove to me that he won’t cheat on me.” The young man looked at me helplessly, raised his eyebrows and shrugged his shoulders. What evidence could he possibly give to validate such a proof? Nothing. All he could do was invite her to trust him.

We all are wounded by experiences of imperfect love. We also are tempted to demand from God proof of His fidelity and goodness. We are like St. Thomas the Apostle who, on that second Sunday of Easter, demands proof of the Lord’s resurrection. “Unless I see the mark of the nail ... I will not believe.” Our science, technology and mathematics can indeed prove a great deal. But there are some things that require trusting another person. We prove promises of love only by trusting.

St. Thomas indeed saw the wounds of Jesus and believed. But there is an even greater blessing for us who simply trust Him — and all the truths the Church proclaims — because of the trustworthiness of the Risen One who speaks. This week let’s trust Jesus without seeing him.

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Reflexión sobre **El Evangelio**

Alentando un Entendimiento Más Profundo de la Escritura

2º Domingo de Pascua (La Divina Misericordia)

Hoy es la octava de Pascua, fiesta central de todo el año litúrgico. Tenemos cincuenta días hasta Pentecostés, para descubrir y experimentar que Jesús es nuestra paz, que su bondad no se ha ido a pesar de nuestros miedos. Señor, necesitamos tu misericordia en el corazón para descubrirte en los que sufren, en los tristes, en los que viven la guerra y la violencia. La paz que nos prometiste desde tu resurrección no es reconocida y practicada. Tal pareciera que hemos olvidado el compartir, escuchar, y vivir en paz de mutuo acuerdo, por el bien común.

Los apóstoles estaban encerrados por miedo a los judíos. A puerta cerrada, escondidos. Jesús penetra esas puertas y se muestra a ellos brindando su paz. Les dice que no estén angustiados, que ha vencido la muerte, el pecado y que en adelante todo va a ser nuevo. Esa misma paz es la que Jesús nos desea a nosotros ahora. Con la fe, que profesamos desde el bautismo, podemos seguir adelante, sin miedo, con valentía, venciendo los obstáculos de la vida que nos impiden estar cerca de Dios. El Santo Papa Juan Pablo II dijo: “Jesucristo es la respuesta definitiva a la pregunta sobre el sentido de la vida y a los interrogantes fundamentales que asedian hoy a tantos hombres y mujeres” (Ecclesia en América, n. 10). Es la paz de Cristo la que nos ayuda a vivir serenos a pesar de todas las inseguridades. ¡Señor, gracias por tu paz!

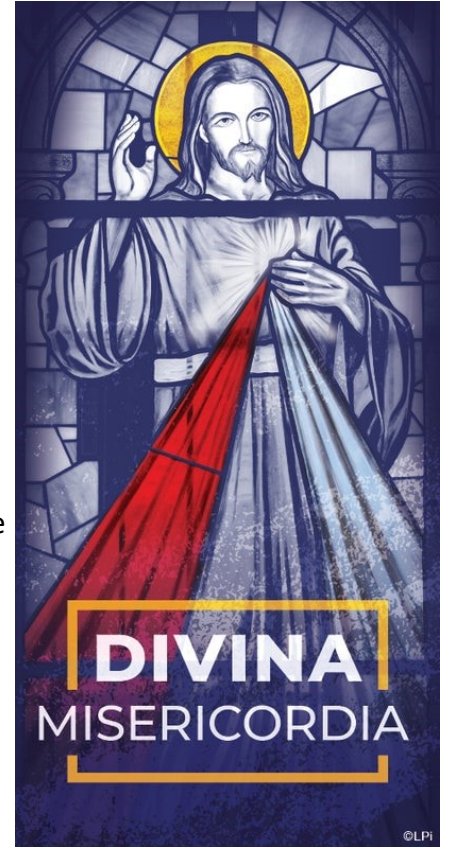

OUR SAINT *of the* WEEK



St. Anselm of Canterbury left his home in Italy to travel as a young man and ended up at the monastery in Bec, France, which was known for the teachings of its leader, Lanfranc. Anselm rose quickly to become abbot of the community and his writings are now compared in importance to those of St. Augustine.

In 1093 Anselm was appointed Archbishop of Canterbury by William II Rufus, the son and successor of William the Conqueror. However, at the time there was a controversy in Europe over whether kings or the pope had the power to invest bishops. Anselm, who believed only the pope should have the right to invest an ecclesiastical authority, spent much of his time as Archbishop exiled in Rome.

St. Anselm's teaching and works of theology are his most important contribution to the Catholic faith. He is considered of the fathers of scholastic theology and his chief achievement in philosophy was the ontological argument for the existence of God. His work *Cur Deus homo?* taught that atonement for sins could only be achieved through Christ. He was canonized in 1494 and named a Doctor of the Church in 1720.

Fiesta de San Anselmo Abril 21

San Anselmo de Canterbury dejó su hogar en Italia para viajar de joven y fue a parar al monasterio de Bec (Francia), conocido por las enseñanzas de su líder, Lanfranco. Anselmo ascendió rápidamente hasta convertirse en abad de la comunidad y sus escritos se comparan en importancia con los de San Agustín.

En 1093, Anselmo fue nombrado arzobispo de Canterbury por Guillermo II Rufo, hijo y sucesor de Guillermo el Conquistador. Sin embargo, en aquella época existía una controversia en Europa sobre si eran los reyes o el Papa quienes tenían el poder de investir a los obispos. Anselmo, que creía que sólo el Papa debía tener derecho a investir a una autoridad eclesiástica, pasó gran parte de su tiempo como arzobispo exiliado en Roma.

Las enseñanzas y obras de teología de San Anselmo son su contribución más importante a la fe católica. Se le considera uno de los padres de la teología escolástica y su principal logro en filosofía fue el argumento ontológico de la existencia de Dios. Su obra *Cur Deus homo?* enseñaba que la expiación de los pecados sólo podía lograrse a través de Cristo. Fue canonizado en 1494 y nombrado Doctor de la Iglesia en 1720.
