A WORD FROM *Fr. Jossey*

Dear Brothers & Sisters

Parish is a family. In a theological atmosphere we could call it Koinonia. The Greek word "Koinonia" means "communion". Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches us that Church in CCC No. 813 "The Church is one *because of her "soul"*. It is the Holy Spirit, dwelling in those who believe and pervading and ruling over the entire Church, who brings about that wonderful **communion** of the faithful and joins them together so intimately in Christ that he is the principle of the Church's unity. "In reality, we are much more than we could imagine. We are invited to be one body, one spirit, which the priest repeats every day in the Mass. St. Clement of Alexandria while speaking about this Unity as of the essence of the Church, teaches the Church, "What an astonishing mystery! There is one Father of the universe, one Logos of the universe, and also on Holy Spirit, everywhere one and the same; there is also one virgin become mother, and I should like to call her "Church." We the parishioners of St. Paul's Church, keeping this nature, could proclaim to our little town of Silverton and also to the whole world that we are in one body and one spirit. I am happy to enlighten you that some people came up to me personally and said that they are feeling like praying in the church a little more now. Some said they would like to pray half an hour, before the mass. Some said, they would like to sit and pray in the church few minutes after the Mass. I wanted to share this happy news with you, because this is something we all should be getting to know as we are one in body and one in spirit. I would like to recommend to all to spend some time before and after the Mass in prayer. I have noticed, that when you want to talk to your friends you move out to the Narthex. By doing so you are setting up a great example, for your fellow brothers and sisters, that you care for their personal prayer time in the church. We will make arrangements for those homebound people also to come and join the Holy Eucharist at least once a month, if they are comfortable to come. I think, the easter visit to the homebound people brought into my mind, this idea. We are planning to have a senior Lunch/dinner too in our parish. We will not ignore those members of our parish because they are sick.

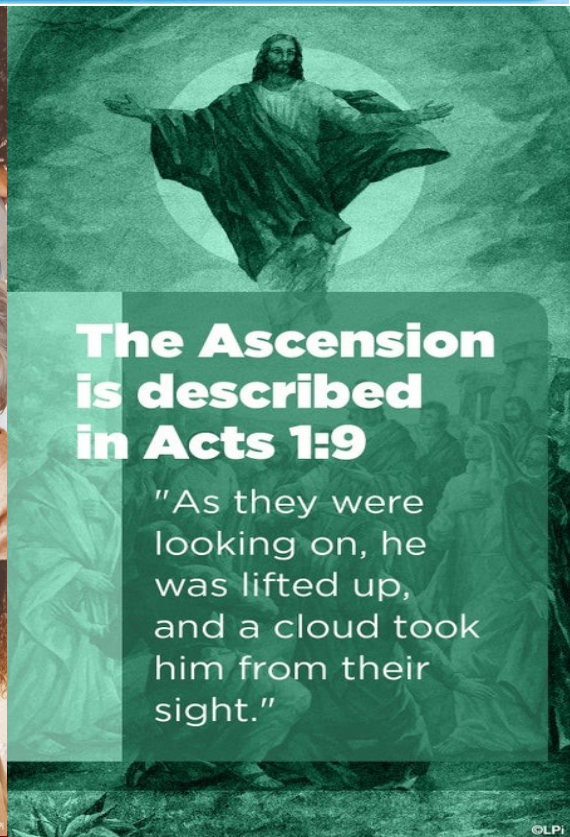
