

EVERYDAY *Stewardship*

After years working for the Church, I can honestly say that even though I feel closer to God, I still cannot fully grasp all that is God. The complexity of God has been the source of many volumes by many writers and theologians. The crazy reality of growing in a relationship with God is that the more you get to know God, the more complex God becomes.

But I think that is true of human relationships as well. I feel like I can really peg a person one way or another after only meeting him or her a few times, but my wife and children continue to perplex me. Getting to know someone means you begin to uncover the layers of personality, feeling, and emotion that make up each human being. For those who see God as only a force or a light, God is simply defined. But for those who seek to be disciples of Jesus Christ, the God we find in relationship has many layers as well.

But that which we do know for certain about God comes to us primarily from the person of Jesus. He called us to a way of life by not only teaching us about how to live, but by showing us the example of his life. Our God is defined by generosity, sacrifice, compassion, and, of course, love. The more we incorporate these characteristics into our own life, the more we bear witness to the true nature of God. Then others can see a God that is a little less complex because they understand him through you and me. Our life will speak more than all the volumes written by all the theologians.

Después de varios años de haber trabajado con la Iglesia, puedo decir con toda honestidad que aunque sí me siento más cercano a Dios, aun no entiendo todo lo que es Dios. La complejidad de Dios ha sido el tema de muchísimos libros de varios escritores y teólogos. La realidad increíble de alimentar su relación con Dios es que cuanto más uno conoce a Dios, él se convierte más complejo.

Pero también creo que esto es verdad para la relación entre seres humanos. Después de interactuar con alguien varias veces yo pienso que sé lo suficiente de esa persona de una manera u otra, pero mi esposa y mis hijos siguen dejándome perplejo. Conocer a alguien significa que uno comienza a descubrir las varias capas de la personalidad y los sentimientos que forman a un ser humano. Para esas personas que consideran a Dios como solo una fuerza o luz exterior, tiene una definición fija. Pero para esas personas que busca ser discípulos de Jesucristo, ese Dios es más complejo y tiene varias capas también.

Las cosas verdaderas y que sí sabemos de Dios son gracias a Jesús. Él nos llama a una manera de vida no simplemente enseñándonos como vivir, pero también mostrándonos su propia vida. Nuestro Dios se define a través de la generosidad, el sacrificio, la compasión y por supuesto el amor. Si incluimos estas características dentro de nuestras propias vidas, seremos testigos a la naturaleza verdadera de Dios. Si lo hacemos, otros podrán ver a Dios de una manera menos complicada porque lo podrán entender e través de tú y yo. Nuestras vidas pueden decir mucho más que todos los libros escritos por los teólogos.

“Reflexión sobre EL EVANGELIO.”

In my experience, one of the peculiarities of being a man is the somewhat unlikely ability to look into the mirror, no matter how out of shape he may be, and declare with full confidence: “Looking good, buddy!” Ask a man. He’ll probably confirm it.

Therein lies a mystery. You might think I refer to man’s ability to deceive himself or his propensity toward vainglory. But in this case, I refer to the mystery of a healthy and proper sense of self-love. We human beings (both men and women) have the utterly weird ability to look at ourselves as if we were another. Then we tend to love this “other.” Then, somehow, that love becomes a bond between the two. We are three and yet one.

This Sunday is Trinity Sunday. We ponder anew that God in His unity is a play of multiplicity: Lover, Beloved, and shared Love. Or, as we also proclaim, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. If we allow it, this mystery heals our temptation toward self-hatred and destruction. We all know how awful it is to look into the mirror and not know the person we see, or, equally bad, to know and hate who we see. Jesus, the Son of God, draws us into the dynamics of authentic self-knowledge and self-love. Perhaps we could ask the Holy Trinity this Sunday to teach us to truly look at ourselves and to properly love who we see looking back.—

Hoy, también, en el texto de Daniel, en lugar del salmo responsorial, la liturgia nos invita a alabar al Señor: “Bendito seas, Señor, Dios de nuestros padres, que tu Nombre sea alabado y glorificado eternamente. Porque eres justo en todo lo que has hecho, todas tus obras son verdaderas, rectos todos tus caminos, y verdaderos todos tus juicios (Daniel 3,26-27). Solo nos resta en todas las actividades y trabajo invocar a la Trinidad. ¡Que Dios uno y Trino viva en los corazones de toda la humanidad y llene de paz y armonía al mundo!


THE POWER & COMPASSION OF COMM.
