"Reflecting Deeper on **THE GOSPEL**
"Reflexion sobre **EL EVANGELIO."**

I am the Lord your God ... You shall not have other gods beside me.
—Ex 20:2-3

Similarly, as we begin Lent, we re-learn the spiritual basics in the Ten Commandments. Consider the first, to “have no other gods besides me.” This is our “grip.” Is our connection to God one of absolute fidelity and exclusive worship? Am I willing to let go of my precious idols, the things I cling to instead of God? Once we say “yes” to this fundamental question of our spiritual “grip,” then we are ready to properly engage with everything else in life. Watch how beautifully the game of life unfolds in the next nine commandments (numbered in parentheses): how we speak to God and others (2 and 8), how we organize our week (3), how we relate to our family (4) and the wider community (5 and 7), how we live our sexuality (6), and how we order all the other desires of the human heart (9 and 10). But don’t rush to these later Commandments too soon! Everything in life is built on the first Commandment. The more we focus on worshiping God alone, the better we navigate the complexity of life with panache, effectiveness, and love.

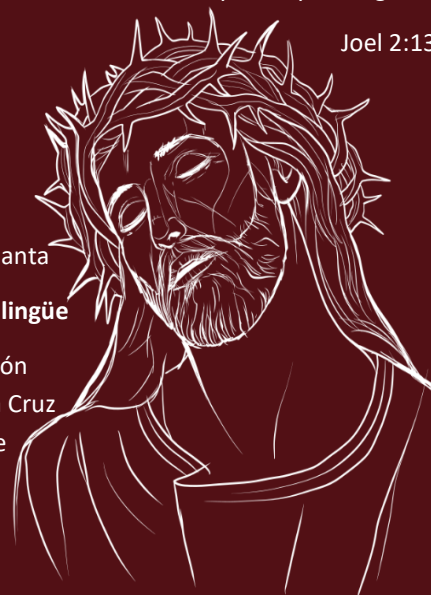

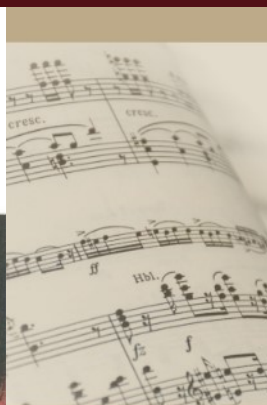

LENT OBLIGATIONS FOR CATHOLICS

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards. Members of the Eastern Catholic Churches are to observe the particular law of their own sui iuris Church. A Reflection on Lenten Fasting If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.

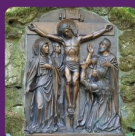

Las normas relativas a la abstinencia de carne son obligatorias para los miembros de la Iglesia católica latina a partir de los 14 años. 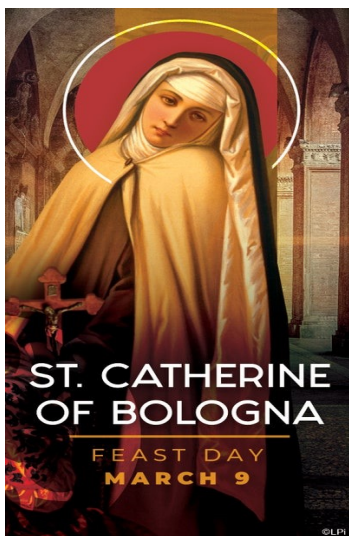
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OUR SAINT *of the* WEEK



Blessed St. Catherine of Bologna (September 8, 1413 – March 9, 1463) came from an upper-class family in Ferrara, a city in Italy, and received an education at the court, where she learned reading, writing, singing and drawing. But despite her advantages, her heart yearned for God. She joined a group of religious women in Ferrara at the age of 18. Four years later, that same group joined the Poor Clares, an order founded by St. Francis and St. Clare of Assisi. In 1456, she and 15 other sisters were sent to establish a Poor Clare monastery in Florence. As abbess, St. Catherine of Bologna worked to establish the new community and maintain a semblance of peace throughout. She was a model of piety and reported experiencing miracles and several visions of Christ, and the Virgin Mary. In 1463, St. Catherine of Bologna became seriously ill, and she passed away. She was buried without a coffin and her body was exhumed 18 days later because of many cures attributed to her at her graveside and the sweet scent coming from her grave. Her body was discovered incorrupt (meaning it was not decaying) and remains so today.

La beata Santa Catalina de Bolonia (8 de septiembre de 1413 - 9 de marzo de 1463) procedía de una familia de clase alta de Ferrara, ciudad de Italia, y recibió educación en la corte, donde aprendió a leer, escribir, cantar y dibujar. Pero a pesar de sus ventajas, su corazón anhelaba a Dios. A los 18 años se unió a un grupo de religiosas en Ferrara. Cuatro años más tarde, ese mismo grupo se unió a las Clarisas, orden fundada por San Francisco y Santa Clara de Asís. En 1456, ella y otras 15 hermanas fueron enviadas a fundar un monasterio de clarisas en Florencia. Como abadesa, Santa Catalina de Bolonia trabajó para establecer la nueva comunidad y mantener una apariencia de paz en todo el monasterio. Fue un modelo de piedad e informó haber experimentado milagros y varias visiones de Cristo y de la Virgen María. En 1463, Santa Catalina de Bolonia enfermó gravemente y falleció. Fue enterrada sin ataúd y su cuerpo fue exhumado 18 días después debido a las numerosas curaciones que se le atribuyeron junto a su tumba y al dulce aroma que salía de ella. Su cuerpo fue descubierto incorrupto (es decir, que no se estaba descomponiendo) y así permanece hasta hoy.
