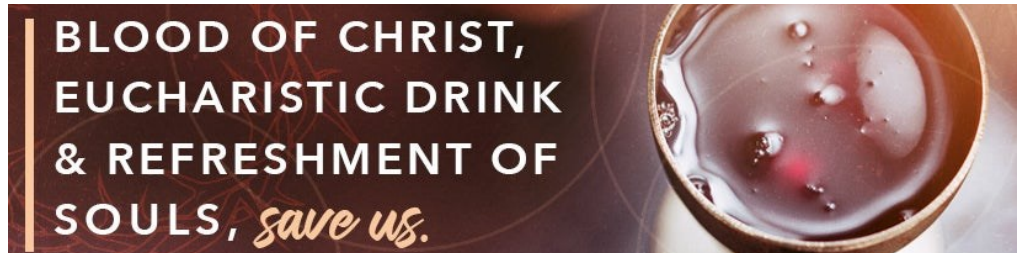

“Reflexion sobre **EL EVANGELIO***.”*

The Feeding of the Five Thousand

In John 6:1-15, we witness Jesus performing a miraculous feeding that demonstrates both his compassion and divine power. As the crowds followed Him, Jesus took five loaves of bread and two fish, blessed them and distributed them to the multitude. Everyone ate their fill, with twelve baskets of leftovers collected afterward.

This miracle serves as a powerful reminder of several important truths:

God's Provision: Just as Jesus provided physical sustenance for the crowds, He provides for our needs today. In times of scarcity or difficulty, we can trust in His abundant provision.

Divine Power: The feeding of the five thousand underscores Jesus' authority over creation. He is not bound by natural laws but can supernaturally intervene in our lives to bring about miracles.

Generosity: The story challenges us to consider our own generosity. The young boy who offered his loaves and fish teaches us that no gift is too small in the hands of Jesus. When we offer what we have, no matter how insignificant it may seem, God can multiply it beyond our expectations.

Spiritual Nourishment: Jesus later identifies Himself as the 'bread of life' (John 6:35), emphasizing that spiritual nourishment is equally important. Just as physical hunger was satisfied that day, Jesus satisfies our spiritual hunger and offers eternal life to all who believe in Him.

As we reflect on this miraculous event, may we be encouraged to trust in God's provision, marvel at His power, and respond with generosity and faith. Let us offer ourselves to Him, knowing that He can multiply our efforts and use them to bless others abundantly.

May this reflection inspire us to seek Jesus daily, knowing that in Him, we find true satisfaction and everlasting life.

La alimentación de los cinco mil

En Juan 6:1-15, Jesús realiza un milagro que demuestra tanto su compasión como su poder divino. Mientras la multitud le seguía, Jesús tomó cinco panes y dos peces, los bendijo y los distribuyó a la multitud. Todos comieron hasta saciarse, y después se recogieron doce cestos con las sobras.

Este milagro es un poderoso recordatorio de varias verdades importantes:

Dios provee: Así como Jesús proveyó el sustento físico para la multitud, Él provee para nuestras necesidades hoy. En tiempos de escasez o dificultad, podemos confiar en Su abundante providencia.

Poder divino: La alimentación de los cinco mil subraya la autoridad de Jesús sobre la creación. Él no está sujeto a las leyes naturales, sino que puede intervenir sobrenaturalmente en nuestras vidas para producir milagros.

Generosidad: La historia nos desafía a considerar nuestra propia generosidad. El joven que ofreció sus panes y sus peces nos enseña que ningún regalo es demasiado pequeño en las manos de Jesús. Cuando ofrecemos lo que tenemos, por insignificante que parezca, Dios puede multiplicarlo más allá de nuestras expectativas.

Alimento espiritual: Más tarde, Jesús se identifica a sí mismo como el «pan de vida» (Juan 6:35), subrayando que el alimento espiritual es igualmente importante. Así como el hambre física fue satisfecha ese día, Jesús satisface nuestra hambre espiritual y ofrece vida eterna a todos los que creen en Él.

Al reflexionar sobre este acontecimiento milagroso, que nos anime a confiar en la providencia de Dios, a maravillarnos ante su poder y a responder con generosidad y fe. Ofrezcámonos a Él, sabiendo que puede multiplicar nuestros esfuerzos y utilizarlos para bendecir abundantemente a los demás.

Que esta reflexión nos inspire a buscar a Jesús cada día, sabiendo que en Él encontramos la verdadera satisfacción y la vida eterna.

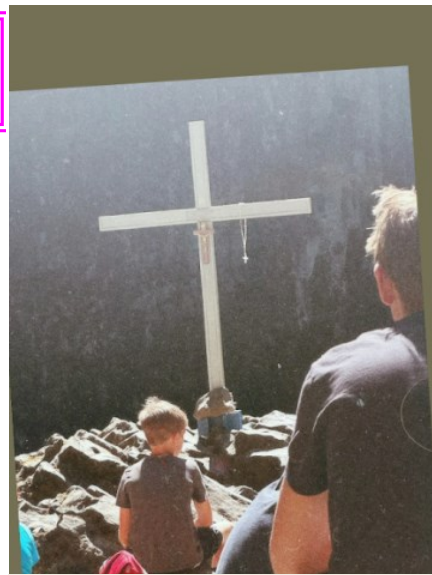
