“Reflecting Deeper on **THE GOSPEL***”*

“Reflexion sobre **EL EVANGELIO***.”*

‘Who Do You Say That I Am?’ (Mark 8:27-35)

- Living Our Faith Boldly

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Jesus asks a big question today, **‘Who do you say that I am?’** It is not just for Peter, but it is for all of us. How we answer shapes our lives and how we live our faith.

1. Recognizing Jesus in Our Lives

Peter got the answer right - **‘You are the Christ’**. But he did not fully understand what it meant. He wanted Jesus to be a powerful king, not one who would suffer. Don’t we sometimes do the same? We want Jesus on our terms - helping us without asking too much from us.

Life is full of struggles - problems at home, work stress, health worries. But Jesus is with us even in our toughest moments. Being a disciple means accepting the hard stuff, not running from it.

2. Faith in Action

St. James tells us today that faith without action is dead. Saying we believe is not enough; we must live it out.

Think of St. Teresa of Calcutta, who saw Jesus in the poorest of the poor. She did not just pray but she rolled up her sleeves and got to work. Her faith was alive because she put it into action.

We can do the same in simple ways:

At Home: Show patience, forgive and be kind.

At Work: Be honest, respectful and supportive.

In Our Community: Help those in need, encourage the lonely and be generous.

3. Embracing the Cross: True Discipleship

Jesus says we must take up our cross to follow Him. That is not easy. It means sacrifice. It means letting go of what holds us back.

St. Francis of Assisi embraced his cross by giving up wealth to serve the poor. He chose the hard path, but it led him closer to Jesus.

What are our crosses? Maybe it is a tough relationship, a heavy workload or our fears. We don’t have to love the struggle, but we can trust that Jesus is with us, making something beautiful out of our pain.

Living Our Faith This Week

Reflect Daily: Ask yourself, ‘Who is Jesus in my life today?’

Serve Simply: Offer a smile, a kind word or a helping hand.

Carry Your Cross: Face our challenges with faith, knowing Jesus walks with us.

Jesus’ question, ‘Who do you say that I am?’ is a call to a deeper, real faith. Let us live boldly, serve others and carry our crosses with hope. Let us be disciples who don’t just speak of Christ but show Him through our lives.

¿Quién decís que soy yo?» (Marcos 8:27-35)

- Vivir la fe con valentía

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

Jesús nos hace hoy una gran pregunta: «¿Quién decís vosotros que soy yo? La forma en que respondemos determina nuestras vidas y cómo vivimos nuestra fe.

1. Reconocer a Jesús en nuestras vidas

Pedro acertó la respuesta: **«Tú eres el Cristo»**. Pero no entendió bien lo que significaba. Quería que Jesús fuera un rey poderoso, no uno que sufriera. ¿No hacemos nosotros lo mismo? Queremos a Jesús a nuestra manera, que nos ayude sin pedirnos demasiado.

La vida está llena de luchas: problemas en casa, estrés en el trabajo, preocupaciones por la salud. Pero Jesús está con nosotros incluso en los momentos más difíciles. Ser discípulo significa aceptar las cosas difíciles, no huir de ellas.

2. La fe en acción

Santiago nos dice hoy que la fe sin acción está muerta. Decir que creemos no es suficiente; debemos vivirlo.

Piensa en Santa Teresa de Calcuta, que vio a Jesús en los más pobres de todos los pobres. No se limitó a rezar, sino que se arremangó las mangas y se puso manos a la obra. Su fe estaba viva porque la puso en práctica.

Nosotros podemos hacer lo mismo de manera sencilla:

En casa: mostrar paciencia, perdonar y ser amables.

En el trabajo: Sé honesto, respetuoso y comprensivo.

En nuestra comunidad: Ayudar a los necesitados, animar a los solitarios y ser generosos.

3. Abrazando la Cruz: El verdadero discipulado

Jesús dice que debemos tomar nuestra cruz para seguirle. Eso no es fácil. Significa sacrificio. Significa renunciar a lo que nos retiene.

San Francisco de Asís abrazó su cruz renunciando a la riqueza para servir a los pobres. Eligió el camino difícil, pero le llevó más cerca de Jesús.

¿Cuáles son nuestras cruces? Tal vez sea una relación difícil, una pesada carga de trabajo o nuestros miedos. No tenemos por qué amar la lucha, pero podemos confiar en que Jesús está con nosotros, haciendo algo hermoso de nuestro dolor.

Vivir nuestra fe esta semana

Reflexiona a diario: Pregúntate: «¿Quién es Jesús en mi vida hoy?»

Sirve con sencillez: Ofrece una sonrisa, una palabra amable o una mano amiga.

Lleva tu cruz: Afronta nuestros retos con fe, sabiendo que Jesús camina con nosotros.

La pregunta de Jesús: «¿Quién decís que soy yo?» es una llamada a una fe más profunda y real. Vivamos con valentía, sirvamos a los demás y llevemos nuestras cruces con esperanza. Seamos discípulos que no sólo hablan de Cristo, sino que lo muestran a través de nuestras vidas.

St. Mary Josphe Rossello (1811-1880) was born to a poor family in Liguria, Italy. She was prevented from entering established religious orders because she lacked a dowry. However, the bishop of Savona helped her open a school and establish her own order, which never required a fee to enter.

Santa María José Rosselló (1811-1880) nació en una familia pobre en Liguria, Italia. Se le impidió entrar en las órdenes religiosas establecidas porque carecía de dote. Sin embargo, el obispo de Savona la ayudó a abrir una escuela y establecer su propia orden, que nunca requirió una cuota para entrar.
