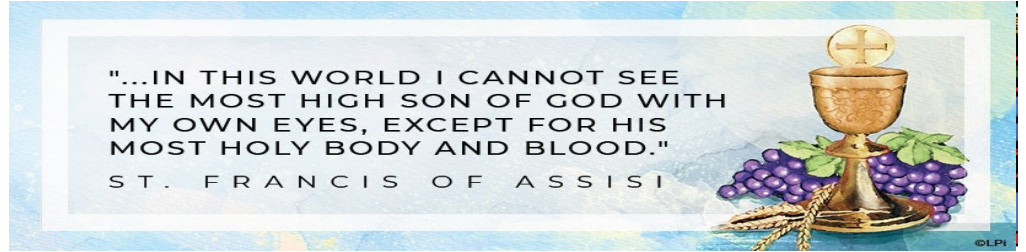

“Reflecting Deeper on **THE GOSPEL***”*

“Reflexion sobre **EL EVANGELIO***.”*

In today's Gospel (Mark 9:38-48), Jesus speaks directly about the need to avoid sin. His words are strong. He says to 'cut off' a hand or 'pluck out' an eye. Jesus is not telling us to harm ourselves. Instead, He shows us something important. **We must be serious about removing anything that leads us or our families away from God.**

This message is important for our daily Christian lives. It is important for our homes as well. Jesus is calling us to make hard choices. Even if these choices are painful, we must act. These choices will help us protect our relationship with Him. They will also help us guard our family's faith.

In our busy lives, it is easy to think of sin only as the 'big' things. But Jesus reminds us to look deeper. **What hidden influences are affecting our homes?**

►Are the TV shows we watch, the conversations we have or the social media we follow reflecting Christian values?

►Are there habits in our daily routines that might be leading us or our children away from God's path?

It is not easy to make these changes. But it is necessary if we want our homes to be places where love, holiness and peace can grow.

Think about the saints. They made hard choices. They removed temptations from their lives.

●**St. Francis of Assisi gave up a life of comfort and wealth to follow Christ more fully.**

●**St. Teresa of Avila disciplined herself to spend time in prayer, even when it was hard, to draw closer to God.**

Their examples teach us something important. Spiritual discipline is possible. It can also be rewarding. Sometimes, it requires sacrifice.

Today, let us reflect as families. We need to think about what we need to 'cut off' or let go of in our homes.

►What habits or influences are distracting us?

►Are they keeping us from living out our faith with honesty?

►How can we ensure we are supporting each other?

We should support one another in our walk with Christ. Let us pray together as families. We will ask for strength and grace to make these changes. We can trust that God will guide us and bring us closer to Him.

Action plan for this week:

What is one small change we can make this week to remove a problem in our life?

How can we help others do the same?

Let us pray for the courage to make these changes, trusting that God's grace will lead us.

En el Evangelio de hoy (Marcos 9:38-48), Jesús habla directamente de la necesidad de evitar el pecado. Sus palabras son contundentes. Dice que 'cortemos' una mano o 'saquemos' un ojo. Jesús no nos dice que nos hagamos daño. En cambio, nos muestra algo importante.

Debemos tomarnos en serio el eliminar cualquier cosa que nos aleje a nosotros o a nuestras familias de Dios.

Este mensaje es importante para nuestra vida cristiana diaria. También es importante para nuestros hogares. Jesús nos llama a tomar decisiones difíciles. Incluso si estas decisiones son dolorosas, debemos actuar. Estas decisiones nos ayudarán a proteger nuestra relación con Él. También nos ayudarán a proteger la fe de nuestra familia.

En nuestras ajetreadas vidas, es fácil pensar que el pecado son sólo las cosas «grandes». Pero Jesús nos recuerda que debemos mirar más profundamente. **Qué influencias ocultas están afectando a nuestros hogares?**

►¿Los programas de televisión que vemos, las conversaciones que mantenemos o las redes sociales que seguimos reflejan valores cristianos?

►¿Hay hábitos en nuestras rutinas diarias que podrían estar alejándonos a nosotros o a nuestros hijos del camino de Dios?

No es fácil hacer estos cambios. Pero es necesario si queremos que nuestros hogares sean lugares donde crezcan el amor, la santidad y la paz.

Piensa en los santos. Tomaron decisiones difíciles. Eliminaron las tentaciones de sus vidas.

●**San Francisco de Asís renunció a una vida de comodidad y riqueza para seguir a Cristo más plenamente.**

●**Santa Teresa de Ávila se disciplinó para dedicar tiempo a la oración, incluso cuando era difícil, para acercarse más a Dios.**

Sus ejemplos nos enseñan algo importante. La disciplina espiritual es posible. También puede ser gratificante. A veces, requiere sacrificio.

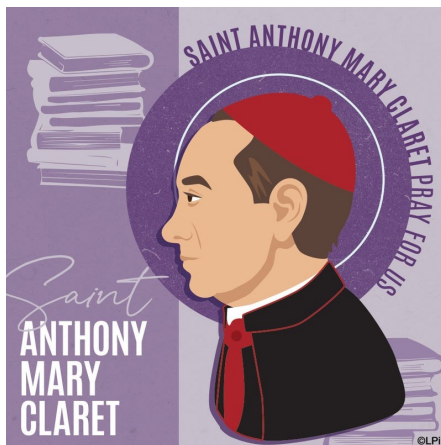

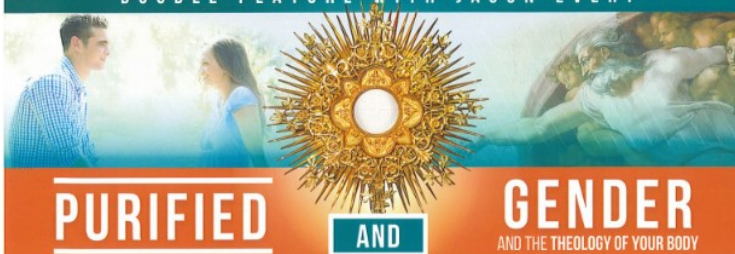
