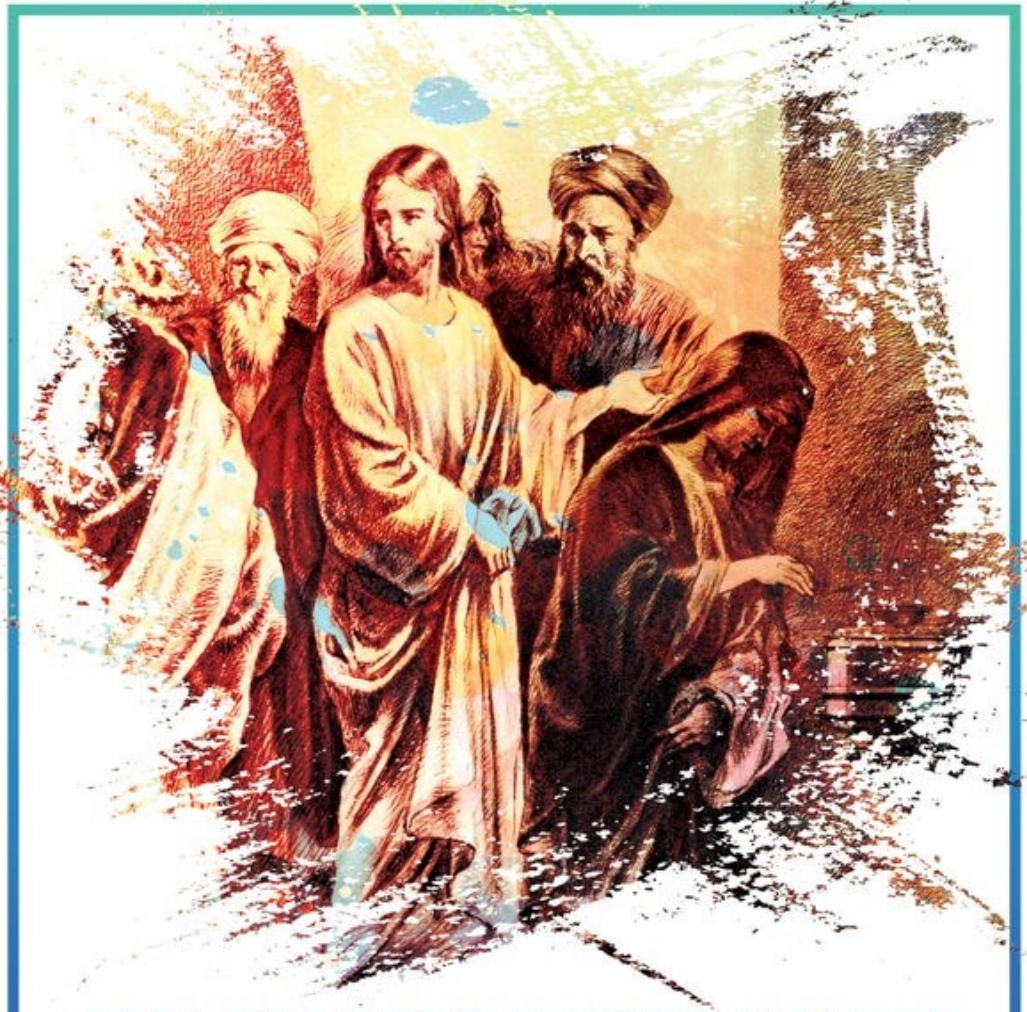

“Reflecting Deeper on **THE GOSPEL***”*

“Reflexion sobre **EL EVANGELIO***.”*

The Beauty and Value of Giving from the Heart - Mark 12:41-44

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

In Mark 12:41-44, Jesus sits opposite the temple treasury. He watches as people offer their contributions. The rich give large sums. But it is the small offering of a poor widow that captures His attention. **She puts in two small coins - worth little in money, but priceless in spirit.**

Jesus tells His disciples, 'Amen, I say to you, this poor widow put in more than all the other contributors to the treasury. For they have all contributed from their surplus wealth, but she, from her poverty, has contributed all she had, her whole livelihood'.

This passage invites us to think about giving. It is easy to see value in the size of a gift. But Jesus shows that real value is in the spirit and sacrifice behind it.

This idea is echoed in today's first reading (1 Kings 17:10-16), where we read about Elijah and the widow of Zarephath. During a severe famine, Elijah meets a widow gathering sticks. He asks her for water and a piece of bread. The widow explains she has only a handful of flour and a little oil - barely enough for one last meal for her and her son. Yet, despite her desperate situation, she trusts Elijah's words and makes him bread first. In return, God provides a miracle: her jar of flour and jug of oil do not run dry until the rain returns.

Connecting these Stories:

Giving in Trust: Both widows gave out of their poverty. The widow in Mark trusted God as she placed her last coins into the treasury. The widow of Zarephath trusted Elijah's promise and gave her last bit of food. **Each act demonstrated deep faith and trust in God's provision.**

Sacrificial Giving: These stories show that true giving often requires personal sacrifice. The widow in Mark gave all she had. The widow in 1 Kings gave from what was meant to sustain her and her son. Yet, **their sacrifices revealed immense faith, which God honored and multiplied.**

God's Response to Faithful Giving: The widow of Zarephath's act of faith was met with God's miraculous provision. Likewise, Jesus praised the widow at the treasury for her heartfelt gift. **These stories remind us that when we give from the heart, God sees and blesses our efforts, often in ways we do not expect.**

Life Applications:

Give with Trust: Like both widows, trust that God will provide, even when giving feels risky.

Embrace Sacrificial Giving: Let our giving stretch our faith, whether it is supporting those in need or dedicating our time and talents.

Reflect on our Intentions: Before giving, ask, 'Am I giving out of routine or out of love and faith?' Even a small gift, given with sincerity, is precious in God's eyes.

As we go into the week, remember this: **God sees the heart behind each gift.** Think of the widow at the temple. Think of the widow of Zarephath. Their stories teach us something important. **Real generosity is not about the size of the gift. It is about the faith and love behind it.** Let us give in ways that show trust in God. Let us serve others with joy.

La belleza y el valor de dar de corazón - Marcos 12:41-44

Queridos hermanos y hermanas

En Marcos 12:41-44, Jesús está sentado frente al tesoro del templo. Observa cómo la gente ofrece sus contribuciones. Los ricos dan grandes sumas. Pero es la pequeña ofrenda de una viuda pobre la que capta su atención. **Pone dos moneditas, que valen poco en dinero, pero no tienen precio en espíritu.** Jesús dice a sus discípulos: «Os aseguro que esta viuda pobre ha echado más que todos los que han contribuido al tesoro. Porque todos han echado de lo que les sobraba, pero ella, desde su pobreza, ha echado todo lo que tenía, todo su sustento».

Este pasaje nos invita a reflexionar sobre la generosidad. Es fácil ver el valor en el tamaño de un regalo. Pero Jesús muestra que el verdadero valor está en el espíritu y el sacrificio que hay detrás.

Esta idea se repite en la primera lectura de hoy (1 Reyes 17:10-16), donde leemos sobre Elías y la viuda de Sarepta. Durante una grave hambruna, Elías se encuentra con una viuda que recogía palos. Le pide agua y un trozo de pan. La viuda le explica que sólo tiene un puñado de harina y un poco de aceite, apenas suficiente para una última comida para ella y su hijo. Sin embargo, a pesar de su desesperada situación, confía en las palabras de Elías y le prepara primero el pan. A cambio, Dios le concede un milagro: su jarra de harina y su cántaro de aceite no se secan hasta que vuelve a llover.

Conectando estas historias:

Dar en confianza: Ambas viudas dieron de su pobreza. La viuda de Marcos confió en Dios al depositar sus últimas monedas en el tesoro. La viuda de Sarepta confió en la promesa de Elías y dio su último pedazo de comida. **Cada acto demostró una profunda fe y confianza en la provisión de Dios.**

Dar con sacrificio: Estas historias muestran que el verdadero dar a menudo requiere sacrificio personal. La viuda de Marcos dio todo lo que tenía. La viuda de 1 Reyes dio de lo que estaba destinado a mantenerla a ella y a su hijo. Sin embargo, sus sacrificios revelaron una fe inmensa, que Dios honró y multiplicó.

La respuesta de Dios a la entrega fiel: El acto de fe de la viuda de Sarepta fue respondido con la provisión milagrosa de Dios. Del mismo modo, Jesús alabó a la viuda del tesoro por su ofrenda sincera. **Estas historias nos recuerdan que cuando damos de corazón, Dios ve y bendice nuestros esfuerzos, a menudo de maneras que no esperamos.**

Aplicaciones para la vida:

Dar con confianza: Como ambas viudas, confía en que Dios proveerá, incluso cuando dar te parezca arriesgado.

Dar con sacrificio: Dejemos que nuestro dar extienda nuestra fe, ya sea apoyando a los necesitados o dedicando nuestro tiempo y talentos.

Reflexionar sobre nuestras intenciones: Antes de dar, pregúntate: «¿Estoy dando por rutina o por amor y fe?». Incluso un pequeño regalo, hecho con sinceridad, es precioso a los ojos de Dios.

Al comenzar la semana, recuerda esto: **Dios ve el corazón detrás de cada regalo.** Piensa en la viuda del templo. Piensa en la viuda de Sarepta. Sus historias nos enseñan algo importante. **La verdadera generosidad no tiene que ver con el tamaño del regalo. Se trata de la fe y el amor que hay detrás.** Demos de manera que mostremos confianza en Dios. Sirvamos a los demás con alegría.

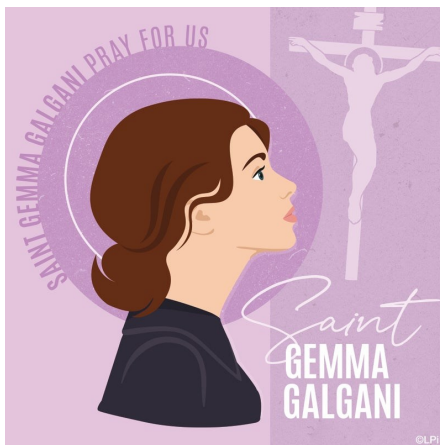

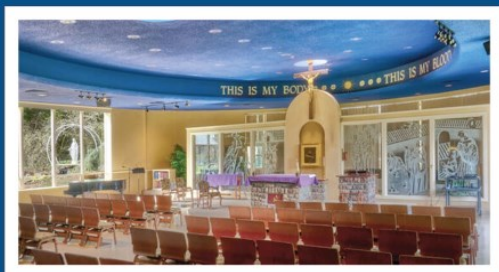
