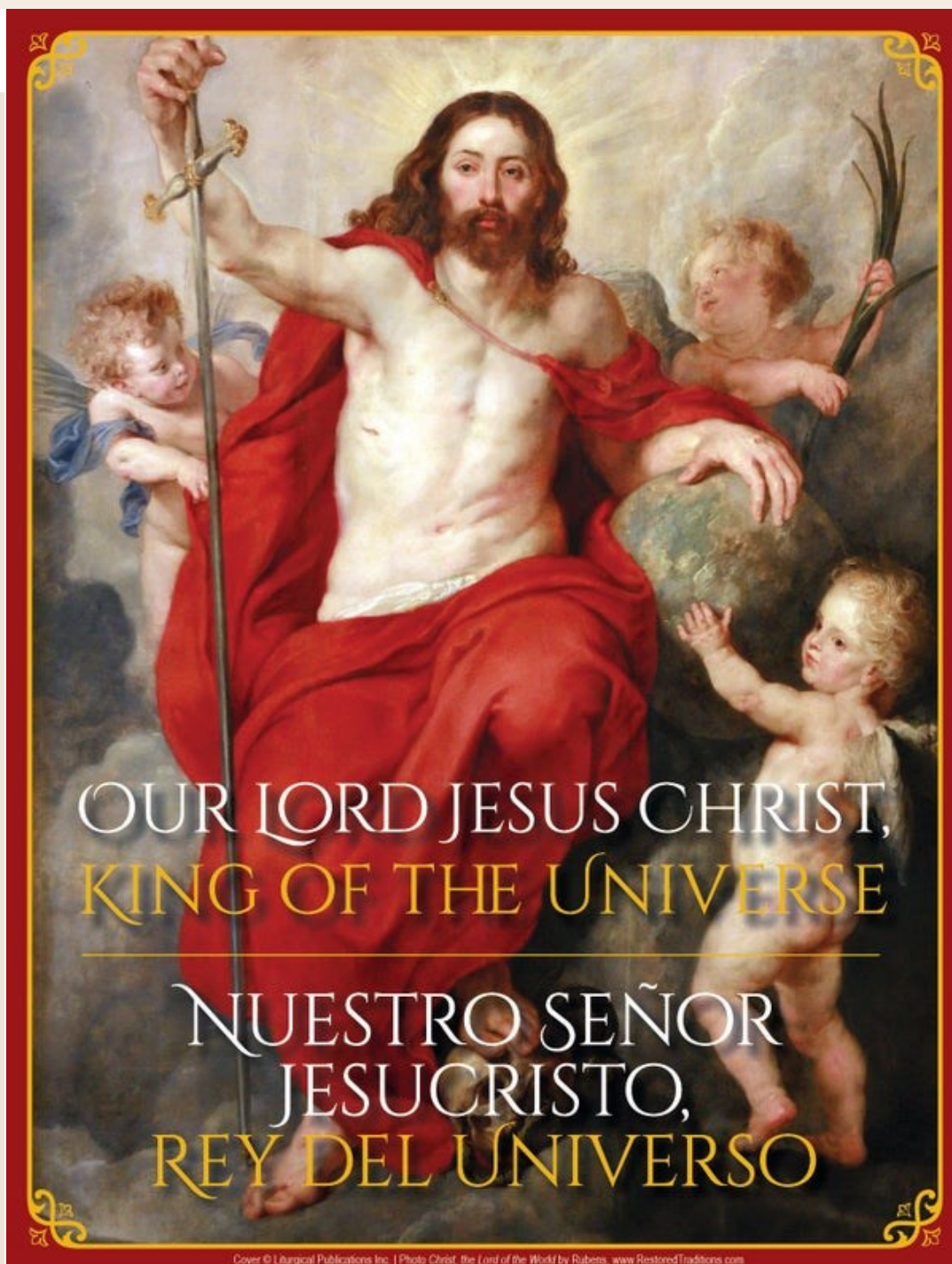

“Reflecting Deeper on **THE GOSPEL***”*

“Reflexion sobre **EL EVANGELIO***.”*

Dear People of God,
This Sunday, we celebrate the Solemnity of **Christ the King**. It marks the end of our liturgical year.

It is a time to reflect on what it means to recognize Jesus as the King of our lives. As we reach this final Sunday before Advent, the Gospel challenges us. It invites us to see Christ's kingship differently - not as power or domination. Instead, **it is a kingship of love, service and humility.**

In the Gospel of John (18:33-37), we see Jesus before Pilate. Pilate asks Him, **‘Are you a king?’** Jesus replies, **‘My kingdom is not from this world’.**

His kingdom is not built on political power or earthly rule. It is built on the values of truth, justice and peace. This reminds us: **Christ's reign is in the small acts of love. It is found in standing up for what is right. It is seen in serving others with a generous heart.**

A young boy helped his grandfather at a small grocery store. One cold winter day, a homeless man came in, shivering and hungry. The boy did not hesitate. He gave the man bread and soup. The grandfather watched in silence. Later, he said to the boy, **‘You have served a king today’.** The boy looked confused. The grandfather explained, **‘Every person in need carries the face of Christ, our true King. You served Him well’.**

This story shows us what Christ's kingship looks like in daily life. It is not found in palaces or titles. It is seen in moments of compassion, forgiveness and mercy. Each time we choose kindness over judgment, we welcome Christ as King. Each time we serve rather than seek our own comfort, we make Christ the ruler of our hearts.

Let us reflect on this solemnity. Who or what truly rules my life? Is it the pursuit of success, power or material things? Or do I let Jesus, the King of Love, guide my choices, my relationships and my actions?

This week, let us find small ways to recognize Christ as our King:

Seek Reconciliation: Is there a relationship in need of healing? Take a step toward forgiveness and peace.

Show Mercy: Look for someone in need - a neighbor, a friend or even a stranger. Offer a kind word or a simple act of service.

Reflect on Scripture: Spend time in prayer with the Gospel. Let Jesus' words shape our heart.

God's Kingdom grows whenever we choose to love like Christ. It may not make the news, but it changes hearts. It transforms lives, starting with our own.

As this liturgical year ends, we prepare for Advent. Let us renew our commitment to follow Christ, our humble King. May His reign of love and peace guide us now and always.

Querido pueblo de Dios,
Este domingo celebramos la solemnidad de **Cristo Rey**. Marca el final de nuestro año litúrgico.

Es un tiempo para reflexionar sobre lo que significa reconocer a Jesús como el Rey de nuestras vidas. Al llegar a este último domingo antes del Adviento, el Evangelio nos interpela. Nos invita a ver la realeza de Cristo de otra manera, no como poder o dominación. Por el contrario, **es un reinado de amor, servicio y humildad.**

En el Evangelio de Juan (18,33-37), vemos a Jesús ante Pilato. Pilato le pregunta: **«¿Eres tú rey?»** Jesús responde: **«Mi reino no es de este mundo».**

Su reino no se basa en el poder político ni en el gobierno terrenal. Está construido sobre los valores de la verdad, la justicia y la paz. Esto nos lo recuerda: **El reino de Cristo está en los pequeños actos de amor. Se encuentra en la defensa de lo que es justo. Se ve en el servicio a los demás con un corazón generoso.**

Un niño ayudó a su abuelo en una pequeña tienda de comestibles. Un frío día de invierno, entró un vagabundo temblando y hambriento. El chico no lo dudó. Le dio pan y sopa. El abuelo observaba en silencio. Más tarde, le dijo: **«Hoy has servido a un rey».** El niño parecía confuso. El abuelo le explicó: **«Toda persona necesitada lleva el rostro de Cristo, nuestro verdadero Rey. Le has servido bien».**

Esta historia nos muestra cómo es la realeza de Cristo en la vida cotidiana. No se encuentra en los palacios ni en los títulos. Se ve en momentos de compasión, perdón y misericordia.

Cada vez que elegimos la bondad en lugar del juicio, damos la bienvenida a Cristo como Rey. Cada vez que servimos en lugar de buscar nuestra propia comodidad, hacemos de Cristo el soberano de nuestros corazones.

Reflexionemos sobre esta solemnidad. ¿Quién o qué gobierna realmente mi vida? ¿Es la búsqueda del éxito, del poder o de las cosas materiales? ¿O dejo que Jesús, el Rey del Amor, guíe mis opciones, mis relaciones y mis acciones?

Esta semana, busquemos pequeñas maneras de reconocer a Cristo como nuestro Rey:

Busca la reconciliación: ¿Hay alguna relación que necesite ser sanada? Da un paso hacia el perdón y la paz.

Muestra misericordia: Busca a alguien que lo necesite: un vecino, un amigo o incluso un desconocido. Ofrece una palabra amable o un simple acto de servicio.

Reflexiona sobre las Escrituras: Pasa tiempo en oración con el Evangelio. Deja que las palabras de Jesús moldeen nuestro corazón.

El Reino de Dios crece siempre que elegimos amar como Cristo. Puede que no salga en las noticias, pero cambia los corazones. Transforma vidas, empezando por la nuestra.

Al terminar este año litúrgico, nos preparamos para el Adviento. Renovemos nuestro compromiso de seguir a Cristo, nuestro humilde Rey. Que su reino de amor y paz nos guíe ahora y siempre.

Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati (1901-1925) was an avid outdoorsman and has become a global patron for youth and young adults. He had difficulties with exams and problems with his parents, but he formed his life around Jesus. St. John Paul II declared him a patron for World Youth Days.
