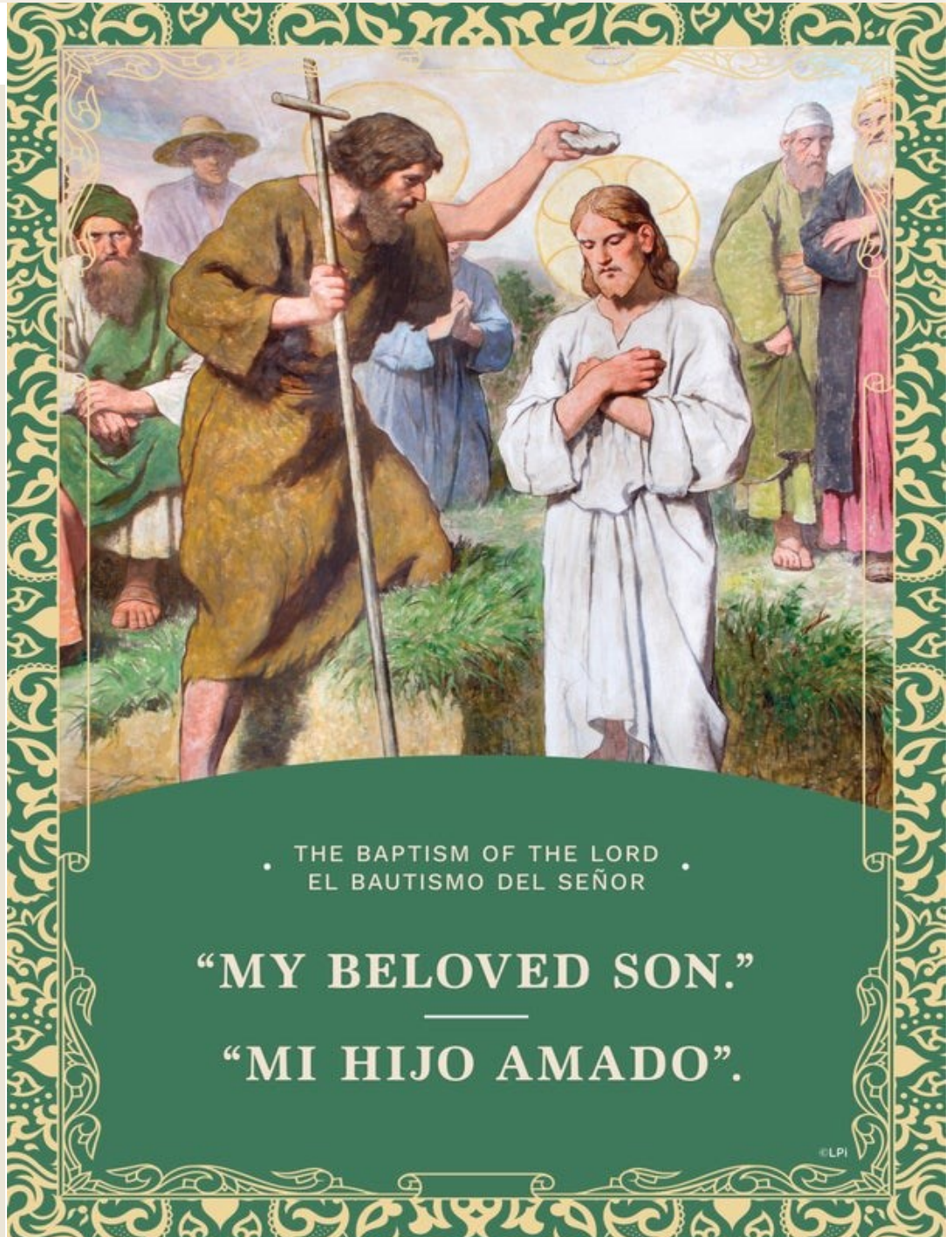

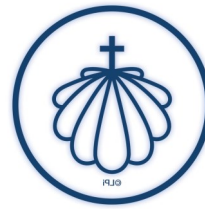

Dear Parishioners,

The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord marks the end of Christmas and the start of Ordinary Time. It invites us to reflect on how our baptism shapes our lives.

1. Walking with Others in Love

Jesus chose baptism to stand with humanity in its weakness. Through our baptism, we are called to walk with others in their struggles, offering compassion and support.

Reflection:

- How can I show compassion to those in need?
- Am I living my call to walk with others in their struggles?

2. Beloved Children of God

At His baptism, the Father called Jesus His Beloved Son. Through baptism, we are also God's beloved children, called to live confidently in His love and share it with others.

Reflection:

Do I live confidently, knowing God loves me unconditionally?

How can I help others see they are beloved by God?

3. The Holy Spirit's Strength

The Holy Spirit, who descended on Jesus, empowers us to live our faith and guides our daily decisions. Let us pray for the Spirit's guidance, especially in moments of weakness or uncertainty.

Reflection:

Where do I need the Spirit's strength in my life?

Am I open to the Spirit's direction?

4. Living Our Baptismal Promises

Baptism begins our journey as disciples. It calls us to reflect God's love, reject sin and live in faith and integrity each day.

Reflection:

How can I live my baptismal promises more fully?

What can I do to reflect God's love in my family, workplace and parish?

Renewing Our Commitment

As we begin this year, let us embrace the grace of baptism and live as God's children. Together, as a parish, may we:

- Support one another with compassion.
- Live confidently as God's beloved.
- Trust the Holy Spirit's guidance.
- Reflect our baptismal promises daily.

May we grow in faith, hope, and love, becoming a light of God's presence in the world.

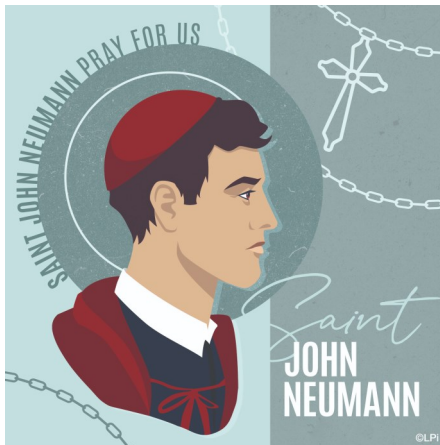

OUR SAINT of the WEEK



Born a pagan, St. Hilary (c. 315 – c. 367) studied philosophy and the meaning of life, eventually making his way through the bible. He became a convert and was appointed bishop of Poitiers in 353. Sometimes referred to as the Hammer of the Arians, St. Hilary defended the Nicene Creed against a popular heresy, Arianism. He was exiled to Phrygia for opposing Roman emperor Constantius II, who preferred the heresy which denies Christ's divinity. From Phrygia St. Hilary fought with his pen, zealously writing against the heresy.

Eventually he was allowed to return to Poitiers, but did so by a circuitous route, preaching against Arianism all the way. St. Hilary was likely the first writer of hymns in the West, his writings on the Trinity, Psalms and Gospel of Matthew survive today. St. Hilary was created Doctor of the Church, a title given to those who provided important contributions to theology and doctrine, in 1851 by Pope Pius IX.

Nacido pagano, san Hilario (c. 315 - c. 367) estudió filosofía y el sentido de la vida, abriéndose camino a través de la Biblia. Se convirtió y fue nombrado obispo de Poitiers en 353. A veces llamado el Martillo de los Arrianos, San Hilario defendió el Credo Niceno contra una herejía popular, el arrianismo. Fue desterrado a Frigia por oponerse al emperador romano Constancio II, que prefería la herejía que niega la divinidad de Cristo. Desde Frigia, San Hilario luchó con su pluma, escribiendo celosamente contra la herejía.

Finalmente se le permitió regresar a Poitiers, pero lo hizo por una ruta tortuosa, predicando contra el arrianismo durante todo el camino. San Hilario fue probablemente el primer escritor de himnos de Occidente, y hoy se conservan sus escritos sobre la Trinidad, los Salmos y el Evangelio de Mateo. En 1851, el Papa Pío IX le concedió el título de Doctor de la Iglesia, que se otorga a quienes han realizado importantes aportaciones a la teología y la doctrina.

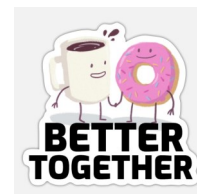
