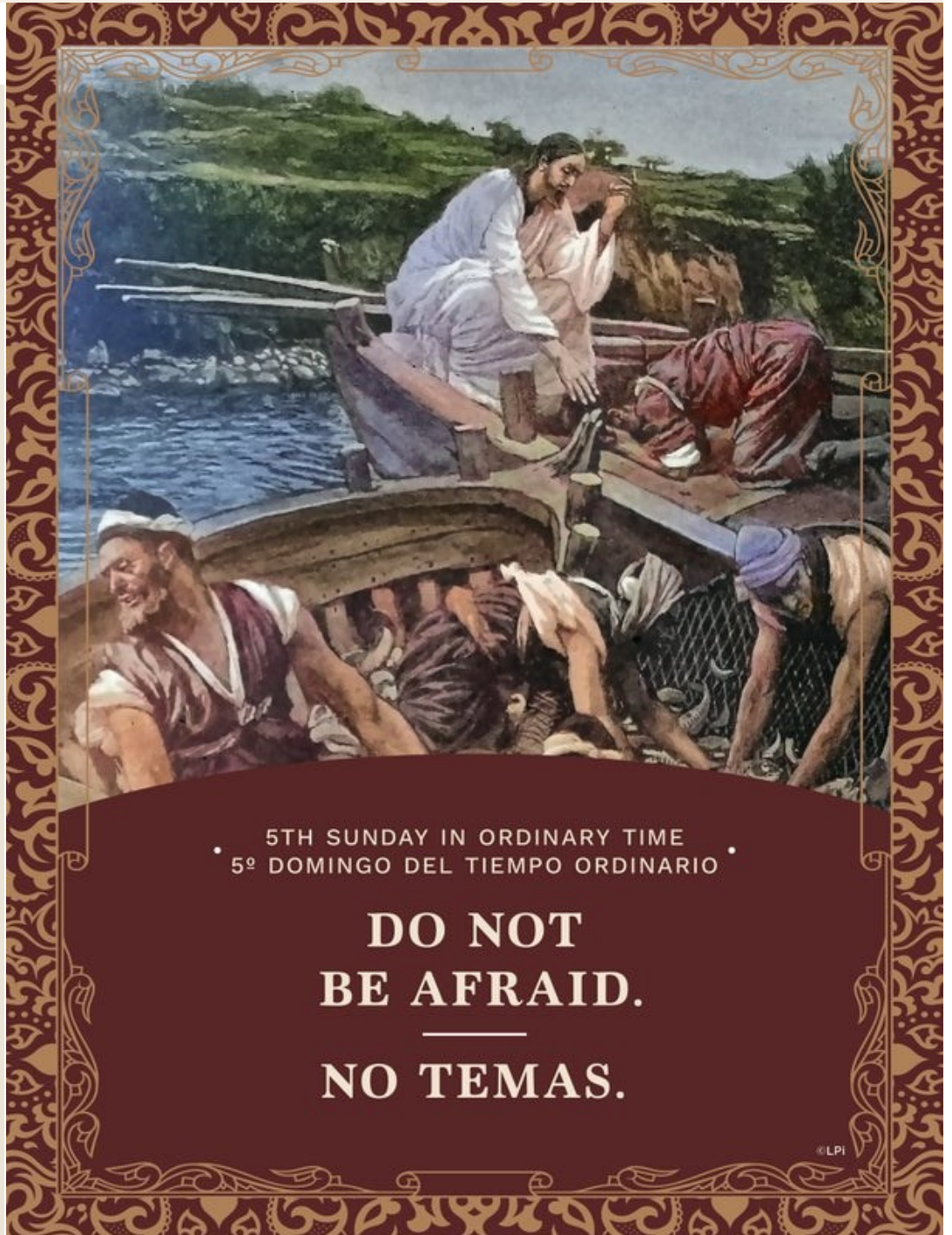

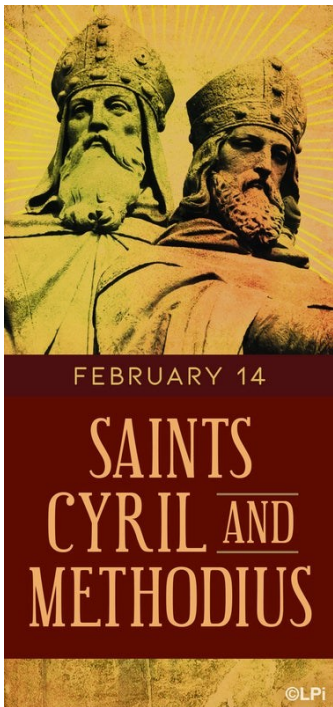

# OUR SAINT of the WEEK



These brothers by birth became brothers in mission. Cyril and Methodius were born to a Greek diplomat in the 800s. The two brothers served in local governmental posts before each withdrew to a monastery. Their lives changed when the political leadership in Eastern Europe — what is now Ukraine — requested priests who spoke the native Slavic languages. Cyril and Methodius had proven themselves as able administrators and holy men, so they were sent as missionaries. First, Cyril invented an alphabet. This became the foundation for what is now used today and is still called the Cyrillic alphabet! Next,

the brothers translated the Gospels, the Psalms, and other liturgical books into the native language of the people. Their work spread across Eastern Europe. God indeed raises up saints for their times!

## SANTOS DE LA SEMANA San Cirilo y San Metodio

Estos hermanos de nacimiento se convirtieron en hermanos de misión. Cirilo y Metodio fueron hijos de un diplomático griego en el siglo VIII. Los dos hermanos desempeñaron cargos gubernamentales locales antes de retirarse cada uno a un monasterio. Sus vidas cambiaron cuando los dirigentes políticos de Europa Oriental -lo que hoy es Ucrania- solicitaron sacerdotes que hablaran las lenguas eslavas nativas. Cirilo y Metodio habían demostrado su capacidad como administradores y santos, por lo que fueron enviados como misioneros. En primer lugar, Cirilo inventó un alfabeto. Este se convirtió en la base del alfabeto que se utiliza hoy en día y que sigue llamándose alfabeto cirílico. A continuación, los hermanos tradujeron los Evangelios, los Salmos y otros libros litúrgicos a la lengua nativa de la gente. Su labor se extendió por toda Europa del Este. Dios suscita santos para su tiempo.
