

“Reflecting Deeper on **THE GOSPEL***”*

“Reflexion sobre **EL EVANGELIO.***”*

We can feel the tension in this week's readings. Jesus is trying to warn his disciples - and us - about the rebellious style of the Pharisees, about hypocrisy. And, he is trying to heal the blindness of his disciples - and us - about what his mission is all about. He has come to free us from sin and the captivity we have to all kinds of self-centered patterns.

So when we stay reflective this week, we can become more conscious of how we rebel from the path of Jesus, from joining him in becoming less selfish. When we begin our days this week, we can ask, "Lord, help me see the ways I'm too self-centered this week. Help me notice the needs of those you place in my life. Stretch my heart to love more today." It is simple, but it begins to change our focus.

As we go through the week, we can pay closer attention to our resistance, the places we catch ourselves holding back. We can open our eyes to see the patterns in our lives that we might not have paid attention to before. It doesn't have to be serious evil we are choosing. It might just be ways in which we are avoiding losing our lives for him. Once we focus, start paying attention to the daily choices we make, our day becomes a day of prayer. We can be in communion with the Lord throughout the day because it becomes a day of dialogue, in the midst of all the busyness. "Lord, as I put on this sweater, I'm aware how I just spoke to Helen. I'm sorry. That was all about my fear, wasn't it? I cut her off because I was just afraid of what she was asking of me. I became more aware of the cost to me than anything else. Please help me to continue to see how I respond to people. Please calm my fears." We can get in the habit of doing this kind of prayer every day, right where we are, in very brief moments. Finding intimacy with God in the midst of our daily lives is the goal of this kind of prayer.

All of this is reinforced by our prayer of gratitude each night. If we are liking this kind of communion with our Lord each day, and thanking God for it each night, there is no question that we will be developing a new pattern in our life. We tend to continue to do what we enjoy. And gratitude feeds even more openness and generosity.

Prayer of God's Blessing

Bless me, Lord, mold my heart in imitation of Yours.
Bless me, Lord, help me to see people as You do and hear their needs.
Bless me, Lord, replace my understanding with Yours.

Amen.

Podemos sentir la tensión en las lecturas de esta semana. Jesús intenta advertir a sus discípulos -y a nosotros- sobre el estilo rebelde de los fariseos, sobre la hipocresía. Y, está tratando de curar la ceguera de sus discípulos - y de nosotros - sobre lo que es su misión. Ha venido a liberarnos del pecado y de la cautividad que tenemos a todo tipo de patrones egocéntricos.

Por eso, cuando reflexionemos esta semana, podremos ser más conscientes de cómo nos rebelamos del camino de Jesús, de unirnos a él para ser menos egoístas. Cuando comencemos nuestros días esta semana, Podemos pedir: «Señor, ayúdame a ver las formas en que soy demasiado egocéntrico esta semana. Ayúdame a darme cuenta de las necesidades de los que pones en mi vida. Inspira hoy mi corazón para que ame más». Es sencillo, pero empieza a cambiar nuestro enfoque.

A lo largo de la semana, podemos prestar más atención a nuestra resistencia, a los lugares en los que nos sorprendemos a nosotros mismos reteniéndonos. Podemos abrir los ojos para ver las pautas de nuestra vida a las que antes no habíamos prestado atención. No tiene por qué ser un mal grave lo que estamos eligiendo. Pueden ser sólo formas en las que estamos evitando perder nuestras vidas por Él. Una vez que nos centramos, empezamos a prestar atención a las elecciones diarias que hacemos, nuestro día se convierte en un día de oración. Podemos estar en comunión con el Señor durante todo el día porque se convierte en un día de diálogo, en medio de todo el ajetreo. «Señor, mientras me pongo este sueter, soy consciente de cómo acabo de hablar a Helen. Perdóname. Se trataba de mi miedo, ¿verdad? La corté porque tenía miedo de lo que me pedía. Fui más consciente del coste para mí que de cualquier otra cosa. Por favor, ayúdame a seguir viendo cómo respondo a la gente. Por favor, calma mis miedos». Podemos acostumbrarnos a hacer este tipo de oración todos los días, allí donde estamos, en momentos muy breves. Encontrar la intimidad con Dios en medio de nuestra vida cotidiana es el objetivo de este tipo de oración.

Todo esto se refuerza con nuestra oración de gratitud cada noche. Si nos gusta este tipo de comunión con nuestro Señor cada día, y damos gracias a Dios por ello cada noche, no hay duda de que estaremos desarrollando un nuevo patrón en nuestra vida. Tendemos a seguir haciendo lo que nos gusta. Y la gratitud alimenta aún más la apertura y la generosidad.


