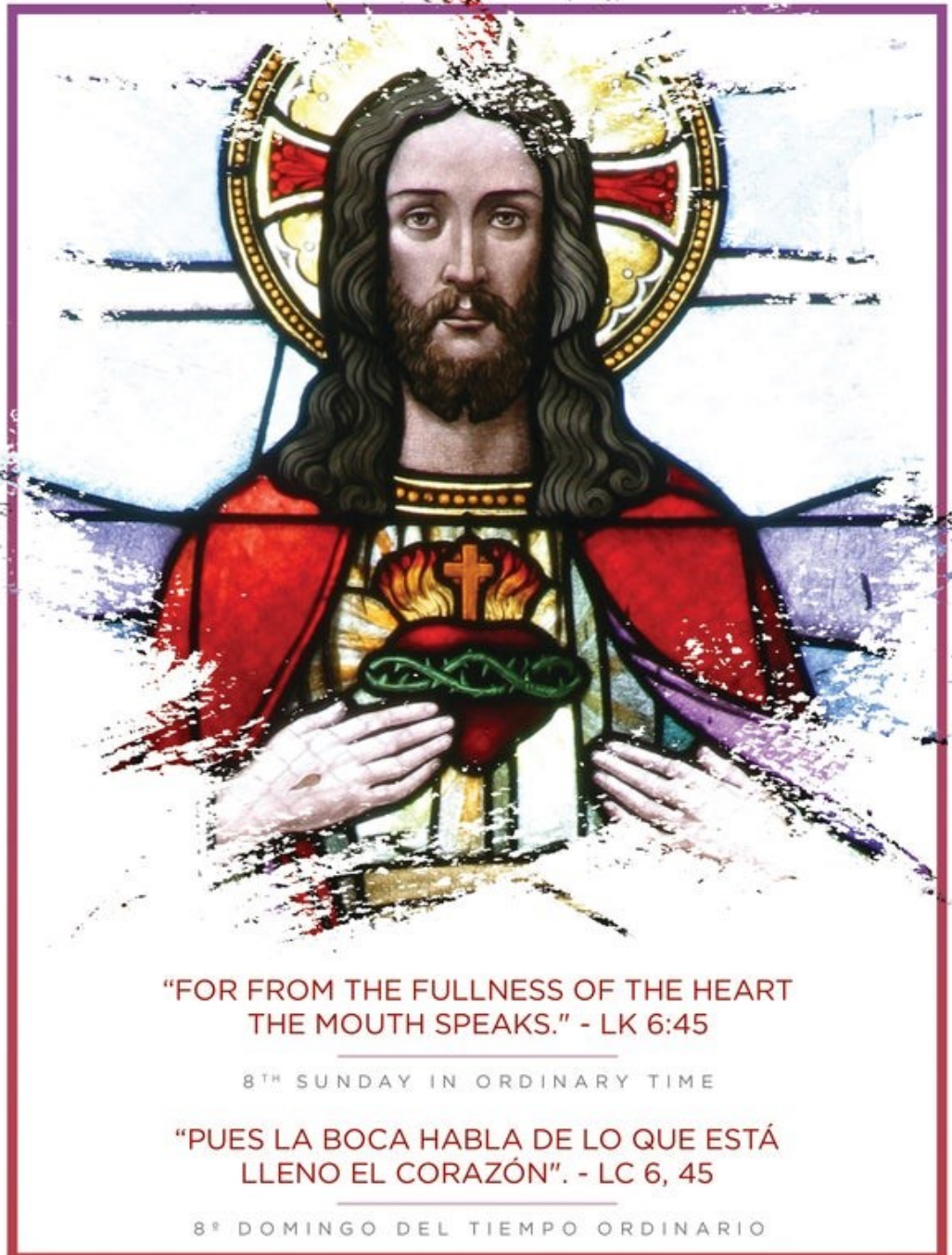

"Reflecting Deeper on THE GOSPEL"

"Reflexion sobre EL EVANGELIO."

We may feel like we never have enough; enough money, time, love, status or anything else that seems to be the focus of our lives. We live lives that are packed with activities, meetings and obligations - keeping our hearts distracted away from our relationship with God, from our families and from others in our lives who need our love.

In these few days before Lent begins, we can begin to prepare our hearts by asking ourselves how we want Lent to be different this year. What do we want to ask the Lord to give us - and more importantly, we can ask what the Lord wants for us this Lent. What gift of generosity, love or attention can we share with others in the weeks ahead? How can we focus on the Lenten season and ask that our hearts be opened to what is real - not to the externals which distract us so much? How will I be with my family and friends this Lent? What will I do that sets this season apart from my normal routines? How can I name, anticipate and feel the gifts the Lord showers on me with such love in the weeks ahead? And every morning, we can begin by sitting at the side of our beds with our hands open on our laps, asking God to help us receive these gifts with open hearts. We can carry that focus with us throughout the day, remembering in the quiet moments what we are asking for. Always, we end our day simply thanking God for the love and gifts of the day.

For these first four days of Lent, it will be a great help to set aside some time, even if it means getting up earlier each morning, to read about what Lent can mean and to let that soak into our hearts. The key is not to be somber or severe in any way, but to know that this is a time of great grace so that we can be attentive to it. The first thing to remember is that these 40 days are a gift to us. We are not trying to save ourselves by our Lenten practices. God has already saved us. We are only trying to let God get our attention and to give grace a chance to work in us. These days are critically important for choosing to establish some Lenten patterns. Depending upon our age or health, we will want to do some fasting and abstinence, in regard to food. But, each of us can choose what else we can fast and abstain from during Lent. What practices of mine get in the way of my being open to hearing God's Word and responding freely? That's what needs transforming. Giving up needing to be right, fasting from my impatience, totally abstaining from escapist fantasies will open our hearts to God's grace. None of that takes extra time. It just takes desire. Adding new acts of kindness, gratitude and love each day for family and friends will open our hearts to the greater acts of charity and generosity for the poor.

Finally, Lent is the perfect time to choose to grow in gratitude. Every night, before going to bed, let us be faithful to giving thanks to the Lord who has given us so many blessings and offers us new graces each and every day.

Podemos sentir que nunca tenemos suficiente; suficiente dinero, tiempo, amor, estatus o cualquier otra cosa que parezca ser el centro de nuestras vidas. Llevamos una vida repleta de actividades, reuniones y obligaciones que distraen nuestro corazón de nuestra relación con Dios, de nuestras familias y de otras personas que necesitan nuestro amor. En estos días previos al comienzo de la Cuaresma, podemos empezar a preparar nuestros corazones preguntándonos cómo queremos que sea la Cuaresma este año. Qué queremos pedirle al Señor que nos regale y, lo que es más importante, podemos preguntarnos qué quiere el Señor para nosotros esta Cuaresma. ¿Qué don de generosidad, amor o atención podemos compartir con los demás en las próximas semanas? ¿Cómo podemos centrarnos en el tiempo de Cuaresma y pedir que nuestros corazones se abran a lo que es real, no a lo externo que tanto nos distrae? ¿Cómo voy a estar con mi familia y mis amigos esta Cuaresma? ¿Qué haré que diferencie este tiempo de mis rutinas habituales? ¿Cómo puedo nombrar, anticipar y sentir los dones que el Señor derrama sobre mí con tanto amor en las próximas semanas? Y cada mañana, podemos empezar por sentarnos junto a la cama con las manos abiertas sobre el regazo, pidiendo a Dios que nos ayude a recibir esos dones con el corazón abierto. Podemos llevar ese enfoque con nosotros a lo largo del día, recordando en los momentos de tranquilidad lo que estamos pidiendo. Siempre, terminamos nuestro día simplemente agradeciendo a Dios por el amor y los dones del día. Para estos primeros cuatro días de Cuaresma, será de gran ayuda reservar un tiempo, aunque sea madrugando cada mañana, para leer sobre lo que puede significar la Cuaresma y dejar que eso penetre en nuestros corazones. La clave no es ser sombrío o severo en modo alguno, sino saber que éste es un tiempo de gran gracia para que podamos estar atentos a él. Lo primero que hay que recordar es que estos 40 días son un regalo para nosotros. No tratamos de salvarnos con nuestras prácticas cuaresmales. Dios ya nos ha salvado. Sólo intentamos que Dios nos preste atención y dar a la gracia la oportunidad de obrar en nosotros. Estos días son muy importantes para elegir establecer algunas pautas cuaresmales. Dependiendo de nuestra edad o salud, querremos hacer algo de ayuno y abstinencia, con respecto a la comida. Pero, cada uno de nosotros puede elegir de qué otras cosas puede ayunar y abstenerse durante la Cuaresma. ¿Qué prácticas me impiden estar abierto a escuchar la Palabra de Dios y responder libremente? Eso es lo que hay que transformar. Renunciar a la necesidad de tener razón, ayunar de mi impaciencia, abstenerme totalmente de fantasías escapistas abrirá nuestros corazones a la gracia de Dios. Nada de eso requiere tiempo extra. Sólo requiere deseo. Añadir nuevos actos de bondad, gratitud y amor cada día para la familia y los amigos abrirá nuestros corazones a los mayores actos de caridad y generosidad para con los pobres. Por último, la Cuaresma es el momento perfecto para elegir crecer en gratitud. Cada noche, antes de acostarnos, seamos fieles a dar gracias al Señor que nos ha dado tantas bendiciones y nos ofrece nuevas gracias cada día.

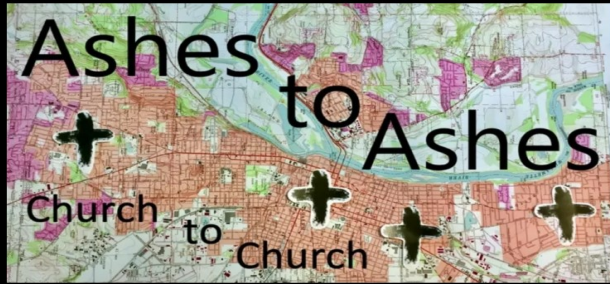

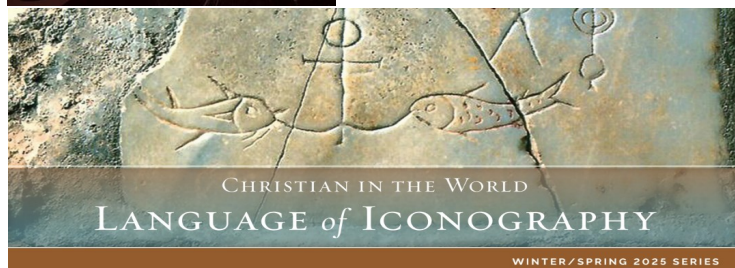


OUR SAINT of the WEEK



St. Katharine Drexel (1858–1955), is one of the first American-born saints. Giving up her inheritance, she founded a religious order which established 63 schools and 50 missions for African and Native Americans, including Xavier University of Louisiana.
