A MESSAGE FROM *Fr. Arulkumar*

UNAS PALABRAS DEL *Padre Arulkumar*

Be Strong in the Lord:

Lent is a time for reflection, repentance and spiritual renewal. On the first Sunday of Lent, we recall the story of Jesus' temptation in the desert, where He faced hunger, power and vanity. Just as He overcame these trials with prayer, fasting and trust in God, so too are we invited to strengthen our faith and draw closer to the Lord during this season.

Temptation Is Real

Temptation is not merely a choice between good and evil; it is often about choosing between trusting God and seeking immediate gratification. The devil tempted Jesus with hunger, power and pride - the same temptations we encounter today. Whether it is the desire for more, the need for control or the pull of vanity, we are called to resist these distractions through prayer, fasting and surrendering to God's will.

The Call to Repentance

Lent is a time for conversion - a time to return to God with all our hearts. The Church invites us to pray, fast and give alms - not as burdens, but as opportunities to realign our lives with the Gospel. This is a season for healing, for turning away from what distances us from God's love and for opening our hearts to His grace.

A Saint's Wisdom

Saint Augustine once said, 'God is always trying to give good things to us, but our hands are too full to receive them'. This Lent, let us empty ourselves - fasting from distractions, sin and worldly attachments - to make room for the good things God desires to give us. By doing so, we create space for His grace to transform us.

Living Out Our Lenten Journey

Prayer: Spend time each day in prayer and reflection. Read Scripture, attend Mass and listen for God's voice in the quiet of your heart. Let this be a time to deepen your relationship with God.

Fasting: Practice self-discipline by fasting from things that pull you away from God - whether that's food, social media, or other distractions. Remember that only God can truly satisfy our deepest needs.

Almsgiving: Serve others through acts of charity and kindness. Give of your time, resources and prayers for those in need. As we give, we open ourselves to the love and generosity of God.

Lent is not a season of despair but of preparation. Just as Jesus found strength in the desert, we too can find spiritual strength as we grow closer to God. Let this Lent be a time of renewal, so that when Easter arrives, we may celebrate the Resurrection of Christ with hearts full of grace and joy. May we walk with Him through this season, allowing His love and strength to guide us.

Sé fuerte en el Señor:

La Cuaresma es tiempo de reflexión, arrepentimiento y renovación espiritual. En el primer domingo de Cuaresma, recordamos la historia de la tentación de Jesús en el desierto, donde se enfrentó al hambre, al poder y a la vanidad. Al igual que Él superó estas pruebas con la oración, el ayuno y la confianza en Dios, también nosotros estamos invitados a fortalecer nuestra fe y a acercarnos más al Señor durante este tiempo.

La tentación es real

La tentación no es simplemente una elección entre el bien y el mal; a menudo se trata de elegir entre confiar en Dios o buscar una gratificación inmediata. El diablo tentó a Jesús con el hambre, el poder y el orgullo - las mismas tentaciones que encontramos hoy. Ya sea el deseo de más, la necesidad de control o la atracción de la vanidad, estamos llamados a resistir estas distracciones mediante la oración, el ayuno y la entrega a la voluntad de Dios.

La llamada al arrepentimiento

La Cuaresma es un tiempo de conversión, un tiempo para volver a Dios de todo corazón. La Iglesia nos invita a rezar, ayunar y dar limosna, no como cargas, sino como oportunidades para realinear nuestras vidas con el Evangelio. Este es un tiempo para sanar, para alejarnos de lo que nos aleja del amor de Dios y para abrir nuestros corazones a su gracia.

La sabiduría de un santo

San Agustín dijo una vez: «Dios siempre está tratando de darnos cosas buenas, pero nuestras manos están demasiado llenas para recibirlas». En esta Cuaresma, vaciémonos de nosotros mismos - ayunando de distracciones, pecados y ataduras mundanas - para dejar espacio a las cosas buenas que Dios desea darnos. Al hacerlo, creamos espacio para que su gracia nos transforme.

Vivir nuestro viaje cuaresmal

Oración: Dedica un tiempo cada día a la oración y a la reflexión. Lee las Escrituras, asiste a Misa y escucha la voz de Dios en la quietud de tu corazón. Deja que este sea un tiempo para profundizar tu relación con Dios.

Ayuno: Practica la autodisciplina ayunando de las cosas que te alejan de Dios, ya sea la comida, las redes sociales u otras distracciones. Recuerda que sólo Dios puede satisfacer nuestras necesidades más profundas.

Dar limosna: Sirve a los demás con actos de caridad y bondad. Ofrece tu tiempo, tus recursos y tus oraciones a los necesitados. Al dar, nos abrimos al amor y la generosidad de Dios.

La Cuaresma no es un tiempo de desesperación, sino de preparación. Al igual que Jesús encontró fortaleza en el desierto, nosotros también podemos encontrar fortaleza espiritual a medida que nos acercamos a Dios. Que esta Cuaresma sea un tiempo de renovación, para que cuando llegue la Pascua podamos celebrar la Resurrección de Cristo con el corazón lleno de gracia y alegría. Que caminemos con Él a lo largo de este tiempo, dejando que su amor y su fuerza nos guíen.

IN LENT, WHAT WE CAN GIVE UP...!

GIVE UP **grumbling!**

Instead, **'In everything give thanks'**. Constructive criticism is OK, but 'moaning, groaning and complaining' are not Christian disciplines.

GIVE UP **10 to 15 minutes in bed!**

Instead, **use that time in prayer**, Bible study and personal devotion.

GIVE UP **looking at other people's worst points.**

Instead **concentrate on their best points.** We all have faults. It is a lot easier to have people overlook our shortcomings when we overlook theirs first

GIVE UP **speaking unkindly.**

Instead, **let our speech be generous and understanding.** It costs so little to say something kind and uplifting. Why not check that sharp tongue at the door?

GIVE UP **our hatred of anyone or anything!**

Instead, **learn the discipline of love.** 'Love covers a multitude of sins'.

GIVE UP **our worries and anxieties!**

Instead, **trust God with them.** Anxiety is spending emotional energy on something we can do nothing about, like tomorrow! Live today and let God's grace be sufficient.

GIVE UP **TV one evening a week!**

Instead, **visit some lonely or sick person.** There are those who are isolated by illness or age. Why isolate our self in front of the 'tube?' Give someone a precious gift: our time!

GIVE UP **buying anything but essentials for ourselves!**

Instead, **give the money to God.** The money we would spend on luxuries could help someone meet basic needs. We are called to be stewards of God's riches, not consumers.

GIVE UP **judging by appearances and by the standard of the world!**

Instead, **learn to give up our self to God.** There is only one who has the right to judge, Jesus Christ.

¡EN CUARESMA, A QUÉ PODEMOS RENUNCIAR...!

¡RENUNCIAR a la queja!

En lugar de eso, **"Dad gracias por todo"**. La crítica constructiva está bien, pero 'quejarse, gemir y lamentarse' no son disciplinas cristianas.

¡RENUNCIA a **10 ó 15 minutos en la cama!**

Utiliza ese tiempo en la oración, el estudio de la Biblia y la devoción personal.

RENUNCIA a **fijarte en los peores aspectos de los demás.**

En lugar de eso, **concéntrate en sus mejores puntos.** Todos tenemos defectos. Es mucho más fácil que la gente pase por alto nuestros defectos cuando nosotros pasamos por alto los suyos primero.

RENUNCIE a **hablar mal.**

En lugar de eso, **que nuestro discurso sea generoso y comprensivo.** Cuesta muy poco decir algo amable y edificante. ¿Por qué no dejar esa lengua afilada en la puerta?

¡RENUNCIEMOS a **odiar a alguien o a algo!**

En su lugar, **aprende la disciplina del amor.** El amor cubre multitud de pecados».

¡RENUNCIAR a **nuestras preocupaciones y ansiedades!**

En lugar de eso, confíalas a Dios. La ansiedad es gastar energía emocional en algo sobre lo que no podemos hacer nada, ¡como el mañana! Vive hoy y deja que la gracia de Dios sea suficiente.

¡RENUNCIA a la **televisión una noche a la semana!**

En su lugar, visita a alguna persona sola o enferma. Hay quienes están aislados por la enfermedad o la edad. ¿Por qué aislarnos frente al «tubo»? Hacer un regalo precioso a alguien: ¡nuestro tiempo!

¡RENUNCIAR a **comprar cualquier cosa que no sea esencial para nosotros mismos!**

En su lugar, **dar el dinero a Dios.** El dinero que gastaríamos en lujos podría ayudar a alguien a cubrir sus necesidades básicas. Estamos llamados a ser administradores de las riquezas de Dios, no consumidores.

¡RENUNCIE a **juzgar por las apariencias y por los criterios del mundo!** En lugar de eso, **aprende a entregarte a Dios.** Sólo hay uno que tiene el derecho de juzgar, Jesucristo.

The fundraiser generated over \$23,000 and the dessert auction produced over \$7,800. Your efforts led to a very fruitful amount of approximately \$50,000 after expenses. These funds will go towards the repair and renovation of the school building and parish hall. This is one of the best events our parish has had in the 15 year history of our community fundraiser. You all came together as a community and showed your support for each other and St. Paul Parish.

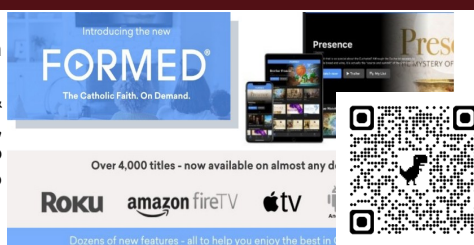

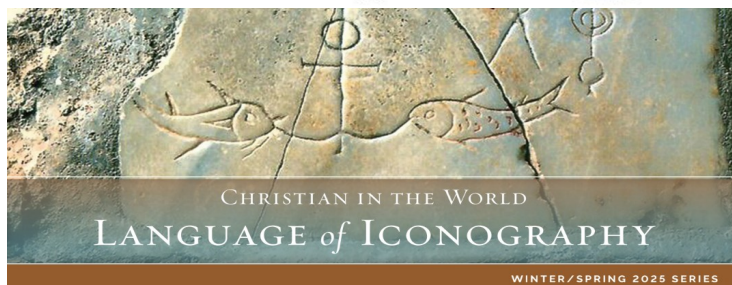
