Embracing Transformation with God's Grace

Dear Parish Family

The Transfiguration reminds us that transformation is not just a past event. It is a call for each of us to become more like Christ today. Jesus reveals His divine glory on the mountain. This glory is available to us, too, in our daily lives.

Lent: A Time for Inner Transformation

Lent is a time to grow closer to God and allow His light to shine in our lives. We often focus on fasting, prayer and almsgiving, but these practices lead us to a deeper change within. Let these actions guide us toward becoming who God calls us to be.

Let God's Light Shine Through You

The Transfiguration gives us a glimpse of the glory that awaits. But transformation takes time. Like Christ, we are called to let God's light shine through us. It is not about perfection, but about allowing God's grace to shape us each day.

Practical Tips for Growing in Your Spiritual Life

Prayer: Take a few minutes each day to pray and listen to God. It does not have to be long or complicated, just a quiet moment where you invite God to speak to your heart. Let this time help you recognize His presence in your daily life.

Acts of Charity: Look for opportunities to serve others. Acts of kindness, big or small, reflect God's love and bring light to the world. Service to others is one of the clearest ways we can express Christ's love.

Self-Reflection: Lent is a time to examine our hearts and lives. Take a moment to reflect on what is hindering your relationship with God. Is there something you need to release or forgive? Allow this season to be a time to remove those obstacles and make room for His transforming grace.

Throughout this Lenten journey, we are not alone. God is with us every step of the way. He guides us with His love and mercy. Jesus walked this path before us. Through His death and resurrection, He offers us strength to continue.

As we reflect on the Transfiguration, let us remember the glory of God. It is not a distant dream but a present reality. We are invited to experience it every day. Trust in God's transforming power. Allow His grace to renew and restore your heart.

Let us pray for the grace to be open to God's love and transformation during this holy season of Lent.

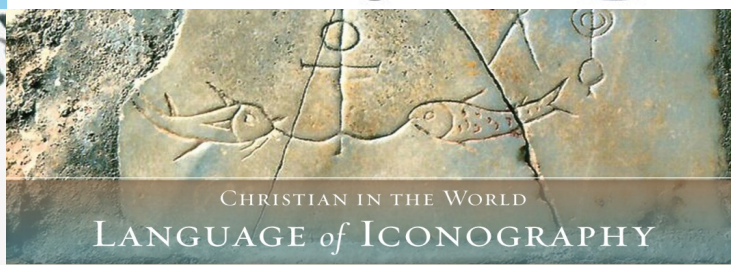
