Pentecost: The Church on Fire!

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,
Today we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost. It marks the day the Holy Spirit came upon the Apostles. They changed from fearful followers to bold preachers. Pentecost is known as the Church's birthday. But it is more than history. It is a call to live each day in the power of the Holy Spirit.

From Fear to Fire

The Apostles were locked in a room, paralyzed by fear. But then **'a sound like a strong driving wind'** filled the house and **tongues of fire** appeared over their heads (Acts 2:2-3). In a moment, everything changed. They went out and **spoke with courage, unity and joy**. What made the difference? **The Holy Spirit**.

In our own lives, fear, fatigue and discouragement can lock us in our own 'upper rooms'. But Pentecost reminds us that **God wants to break through those walls** with the fire of His Spirit.

One Spirit, Many Gifts

The Holy Spirit is not given only to the few or the ordained. St. Paul reminds us that though we are many, **we are one body in Christ** (1 Corinthians 12). Each of us has **a gift**, a calling, a mission - given for the good of others.

Ask yourself:

What gift has the Holy Spirit given me to serve in my family, parish, workplace .or community?

Pentecost challenges us to stop comparing, hiding or doubting our gifts and to **start using them boldly**. The Church needs **your fire**.

Breathing the Spirit Daily

It is easy to think of Pentecost as a once-a-year celebration. But the early Christians lived Pentecost every day - praying together, breaking bread, serving the poor and witnessing with joy.

We are called to do the same. How?

- Begin each day with a simple prayer: **'Come, Holy Spirit'**
- Open your heart to interruptions - they might be Spirit-led invitations.
- Speak words that build up, encourage and unify.
- Forgive boldly. Love generously. Serve humbly

A Parish on Fire

Imagine if our parish were known not just for its Mass schedule, but for its **joy, warmth, generosity and spiritual power**. That vision is possible - **if we welcome the Holy Spirit with open hearts**.

Let this Pentecost not be just a memory of what God did **then**, but a renewal of what God wants to do **now** - in you, in your family and in our parish.

Come, Holy Spirit. Renew the face of the earth - starting with us.

Pentecostés: La Iglesia en llamas

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,
Hoy celebramos la fiesta de Pentecostés. Marca el día en que el Espíritu Santo vino sobre los Apóstoles. Pasaron de ser temerosos seguidores a audaces predicadores. Pentecostés es conocido como el cumpleaños de la Iglesia. Pero es más que historia. Es una llamada a vivir cada día con el poder del Espíritu Santo.

Del miedo al fuego

Los Apóstoles estaban encerrados en una habitación, paralizados por el miedo. Pero entonces «un ruido como de viento impetuoso» llenó la casa y sobre sus cabezas aparecieron lenguas de fuego (Hch 2,2-3). En un momento, todo cambió. **Salieron y hablaron con valentía, unidad y alegría**. ¿Qué marcó la diferencia? **El Espíritu Santo**.

En nuestras propias vidas, el miedo, el cansancio y el desánimo pueden encerrarnos en nuestros propios «aposentos superiores». Pero Pentecostés nos recuerda que Dios quiere atravesar esos muros con el fuego de su Espíritu.

Un Espíritu, muchos dones

El Espíritu Santo no se da sólo a unos pocos o a los ordenados. San Pablo nos recuerda que, aunque somos muchos, somos **un solo cuerpo en Cristo** (1 Corintios 12). Cada uno de nosotros tiene **un don**, una vocación, una misión, que se nos da para el bien de los demás.

Pregúntate a ti mismo:

¿Qué don me ha dado el Espíritu Santo para servir en mi familia, parroquia, lugar de trabajo o comunidad?

Pentecostés nos desafía a dejar de comparar, esconder o dudar de nuestros dones y a **empezar a utilizarlos con valentía**. La Iglesia necesita **tu fuego**.

Respirar el Espíritu a diario

Es fácil pensar en Pentecostés como una celebración que tiene lugar una vez al año. Pero los primeros cristianos vivían Pentecostés todos los días: rezando juntos, partiendo el pan, sirviendo a los pobres y dando testimonio con alegría.

Nosotros estamos llamados a hacer lo mismo. ¿Cómo?

- Comienza cada día con una sencilla oración: **«Ven, Espíritu Santo»**
- Abre tu corazón a las interrupciones: pueden ser invitaciones guiadas por el Espíritu.
- Di palabras que edifiquen, animen y unifiquen.
- Perdona con valentía. Ama con generosidad. Sirve con humildad.

Una parroquia en llamas

Imaginemos que nuestra parroquia fuera conocida no sólo por su horario de misas, sino por su alegría, **calidez, generosidad y fuerza espiritual**. Esa visión es posible, **si acogemos al Espíritu Santo con el corazón abierto**.

Que este Pentecostés no sea sólo un recuerdo de lo que Dios hizo entonces, sino una renovación de lo que Dios quiere hacer ahora - en ti, en tu familia y en nuestra parroquia.

Ven, Espíritu Santo. Renueva la faz de la tierra, empezando por nosotros.

3. Trust in God's Plan.

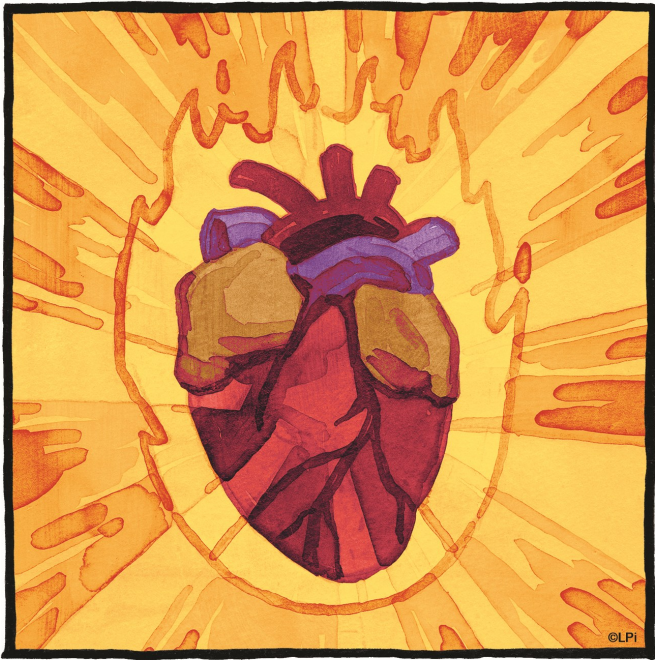
