- A primary aim is to get our Youth Ministry more involved in our function in the parish to help them know what we do.
- Look at putting our meeting time when the "worker bees" who cannot attend during the day can attend.
- Look at ways to get Youth Group, Young married couple, Young adult Ministry more involved in Pro-Life Ministry. Help the Pastoral Council implement a "culture of life" in our parish...not just tell them what to do!!
- Look at supporting a "Ministry Faire" in the parish again when COVID restrictions are lifted to get the word out about many Parish Ministries including our own ...and always look for more pertinent information to add to our Parish Website!

- Discussion about Life Chain events. Should we sponsor one of our own in Silverton? Join Stayton? Keep supporting our "corner" in Salem? Ethel expressed concern that we might spreading available volunteers too thin with additional locations. Cathy to speak to Marie about this and report back in June. The matching funds could be up to about \$3000 for an event. It may be a good match for a speaker or teacher event. Keep in mind, there is a director's fund in our council's budget of \$600 as well.
