Dear Parish Family,



Income

Our ordinary Sunday collections remain the foundation of our parish support, providing nearly three-quarters of our income.

We received helpful support from the Diocese of Helena Foundation, as well as modest special collections at Christmas and Easter.

Restricted gifts and capital donations remind us of the generosity of parishioners who give when there are specific needs.




Expenses

The largest portions of our budget go to priest salary and benefits, insurance, and utilities — the basic needs of parish life.

The Diocesan Assessment supports the wider mission of our diocese.

Other expenses include parish events, hospitality, maintenance, and supplies.
