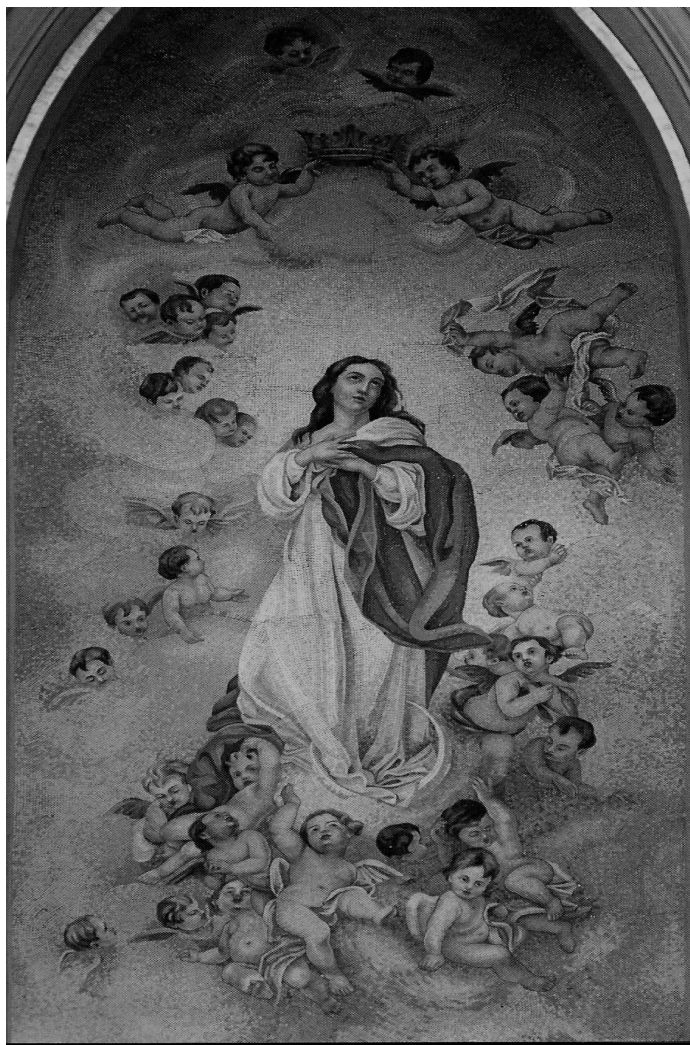
Baptisms are celebrated the 2nd and 4th Saturday of every month at 11 AM. For more information, please contact the parish office.

The Nativity of St. John the Baptist

John the Baptist spent his adult life preparing the way for Jesus, and proclaiming that “the Kingdom of Heaven is close at hand.” He was born to Zachary and Elizabeth, an elderly married couple. The Angel Gabriel had visited Zachary and told him that his wife would bear a child, even though she was already past the child-bearing age. Elizabeth was Mary’s cousin and Zachary was a priest of the Temple in Jerusalem. As a baby in the womb, John recognized Jesus’ presence in Mary’s womb when Mary visited Elizabeth soon after the Annunciation. Both women were pregnant at the same time. John was probably born at Ain-Karim, which is southwest of Jerusalem. As a young adult, he lived as

a hermit in the desert of Judea until about A.D. 27. When he was 30, he began to preach on the banks of the Jordan, calling for repentance and baptizing people in the river waters. When Jesus came to John to be baptized, John recognized Jesus as the Messiah and baptized Him, saying: “It is I who need baptism from you.” John continued to preach after Jesus was baptized, but was imprisoned not long after by Herod Antipas, after he denounced the king’s adulterous marriage with Herodias, wife of his half-brother Philip. John was beheaded at the request of Salome, daughter of Herodias. Many came to know Jesus through John, namely the Apostles Andrew and John.

La Natividad de San Juan Bautista

Juan el Bautista pasó su vida adulta preparando el camino para Jesús y proclamando que "el Reino de los Cielos está cerca". Nació de Zacarías y Elizabeth, una pareja de ancianos casados. El ángel Gabriel había visitado a Zacarías y le dijo que su esposa tendría un hijo, a pesar de que ya había pasado la edad de procrear. Isabel era prima de María y Zacarías era sacerdote del Templo en Jerusalén. Cuando era un bebé en el seno, John reconoció la presencia de Jesús en el seno de María cuando María visitó a Elizabeth poco después de la Anunciación. Ambas mujeres estaban embarazadas al mismo tiempo. John probablemente nació en Ain-Karim, que está al suroeste de Jerusalén. Cuando

era un adulto joven, vivió como ermitaño en el desierto de Judea hasta aproximadamente el año 27 d. C. Cuando tenía 30 años, comenzó a predicar a orillas del Jordán, pidiendo arrepentimiento y bautizando a las personas en las aguas del río. Cuando Jesús vino a Juan para bautizarse, Juan reconoció a Jesús como el Mesías y lo bautizó, diciendo: "Soy yo quien necesito el bautismo de usted". Juan continuó predicando después de que Jesús fue bautizado, pero fue encarcelado poco después por Herodes Antipas, luego de denunciar el matrimonio adúltero del rey con Herodías, esposa de su medio hermano Felipe. John fue decapitado a petición de Salomé, hija de Herodías. Muchos llegaron a conocer a Jesús a través de Juan, a saber, los apóstoles Andrés y Juan.

Saturdays 5:00 pm English and 7:00 pm Spanish

Sundays 9:00 am English

Sundays 11:00 am Spanish and 12:00 pm (noon) Spanish

7. Week day Masses will begin June 15th. There will be no novena on Mondays.

8. The Mass will also be posted on Facebook.
