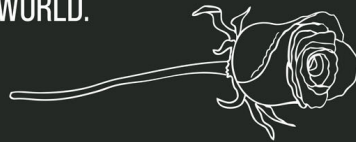

Dear Parishioners,

Happy May! Happy First Communion weekend! Happy May Crowning weekend! First Communion and May Crowning are two wonderful events of our Catholic culture. This weekend 28 young children will receive their first Holy Communion at the 4 pm Mass. Gail Monroe, their catechists, Fr. Scott, and I have been supporting their parents in preparing them for this special day. It is one of the highlights of the year to see the joy and excitement as they receive Jesus for the very first time. It is my hope and prayer that they will inspire all of us to renew our joy and excitement for receiving the Holy Eucharist.



Our Legion of Mary will be hosting a May Crowning at 12:15 pm in the Church today, May 6. Mary is the “Queen” of the church and our Queen, who always intercedes to her son, Jesus, on our behalf. She was the first disciple, the first to say “yes” when asked to serve the Lord. It is her “yes” that we all seek to model in our lives.

As you may have heard by now, Fr. Scott will be completing his four-year assignment with us in early June, and the Bishop has assigned him to St. Mary Parish in Hudson as of June 12. Fr. Scott has been such a great leader in our community, and we have all been blessed by his ministry. Personally, I am incredibly sad at the loss of Fr. Scott from our parish. However, this is the life of the Diocesan priest. We are ordained for the service of the Diocese and called to share our gifts and talents with other parishes. It is important to give him another parish experience prior to his being made a pastor in a few years. As you may remember, I served at St. Mary in Hudson prior to coming here in January of 2010. I know the parish well, and I know they will take great care of our Fr. Scott. He will also be a blessing to them! Fr. Scott is still with us for over a month and I know will continue to minister to us. We will formally say good-bye and farewell on June 10 at the 11 am Mass. We are planning a picnic after the Mass, so I hope you can join us. Check elsewhere in the bulletin for more information.

Fr. Scott was so awesome that Bishop Perez had to assign TWO new Parochial Vicars to replace him here at SRW. Bishop Perez has assigned Fr. Tim Roth and Fr. Tom Kowatch to our parish as of June 12. Fr. Tim was assigned here when he was a transitional deacon (known as Deacon Tim) in 2013 – 2014. He is a classmate of Fr. Scott, and I know him well. He has been serving at St. Angela Parish in Fairview Park. Fr. Tom Kowatch was ordained in 1985. He has had a number of different assignments and is currently serving at St. Francis Xavier Parish in Medina. I do not know him well but look forward to meeting him and ministering with him. Both of them have been assigned to SRW for four-year terms. Several people have asked me why the Bishop has assigned us two priests. He has done so because of my added responsibilities as Administrator of St. John of the Cross Parish. My sense from the Bishop is he is considering making this more long-term than short-term. However, I am working with his staff on formalizing this reality. It is not beyond the realm of possibility that the Bishop will ask me and these two priests to serve the Sacramental, spiritual, and pastoral needs of both parishes. This would be done with both parishes keeping their own identity. In many places in the country this sort of model is being done. Nothing is for sure yet, but this does seem to be the direction we may be going. Thank God I am a big guy with a big heart (that is nice and healthy – I just had a checkup) that can love two parish communities. There are other possibilities. We will just have to see what the Bishop and Holy Spirit have in store. Please keep this in your prayers!

BLOOD DRIVE

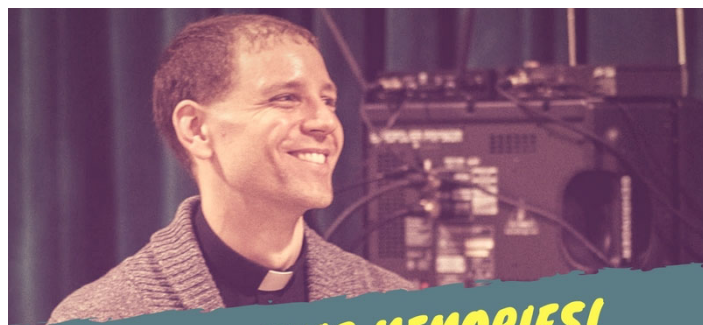
