



Dear Parishioners,

I wanted to share with you some exciting news. We will have two new staff members joining us in the coming months.



Bill Olson will be our Youth & Young Adult Minister and Adult Faith Formation Director. He will serve both parishes. Although there are not a **lot** of young people at SJC, to ensure the future of our parishes we must engage the teens and young adults who **are** there. He will be responsible for EDGE (grades 6, 7 & 8), PSR (7 & 8), Confirmation, LIFETEEN, Colloquy (Young Adult Ministry), and Adult Faith Formation (Bible Studies, Theology Studies, FORMED, Parish Mission, etc.) The Adult Faith Formation will be done in collaboration with the clergy (Priests/Deacons) and Renee Barber.



Bill grew up in Minnesota and has worked as a missionary, youth minister, and campus minister. He has been in Texas the last two years working at a Jesuit High School. He is in a serious relationship with a woman who lives here in Cleveland and he wants to establish roots here. He will start in early July.



Deacon Tom Shetina was ordained a permanent deacon on May 4 and assigned to both SJC and SRW for a six-year term, renewable more than once. Deacon Tom and his wife Lee live in Mentor and attend St. John Vianney. I have known him since my days there. Deacon Tom also did some field work here at SRW while in formation to become a deacon. Deacon Tom and I will be meeting on Saturday to talk about his role at both parishes. He does have a regular full time job. I envision that he will spend most of his time at SJC. I have asked him to be present at all weekend Masses, help coordinate them, and make sure we do them to the best of our ability. He will also be getting involved in some of the ministries at both SRW and SJC. It is an honor that the Bishop has chosen our parish for a newly ordained deacon. He will start in late May.

This week Deacon Joe Robinson will be joining us. He will serve one year with us in his final year of formation to be ordained a priest. He will introduce himself in the coming weeks.

As you know Fr. Tim Roth has been assigned to study in Rome for a doctorate degree in Canon Law. This will end his assignment here in Euclid at SRW & SJC. His last day with us will be May 31. Please keep Fr. Tim in your prayers as he makes this transition in his life. I know it will not be easy to be out of the country for five years, but I know he will do great things for our Diocesan church. Please mark your calendars for Sunday, May 26. The 11:00 am Mass at Ss. Robert & William Parish will be followed by a picnic on the SRW grounds. Please RSVP to the parish office, 216.731.1515.

Kate Betters, will also be leaving us as Youth Minister on June 1. She will take the summer off and then begin work in our Guardian Angels Early Learning Center teaching our young children.

While it is always sad to see staff members leave, it is always awesome to have new ones join us on the journey.


Buongiorno


