Happy last weekend of July! Time is certainly flying by. I wanted to share with you that both Ss. Robert & William and St. John of the Cross will start a new weekday Mass schedule on Monday, August 3. Both parishes will once again offer weekday Mass at their own location. We will still LIVESTREAM the Masses from Ss. Robert & William so those who are unable to attend in person may still participate.

This schedule offers a variety of complimentary Mass times at each parish for people to choose from, which is a good thing.

Today at SJC we are celebrating First Communion for two of our young people. At SRW we have had a few First Communion and have a few more scheduled in the coming weeks. SRW will host a large group First Communion on September 12. It is not ideal, but the families have all made it work. In the coming weeks we will list all the children's names in the bulletin, but until then please keep them in your prayers as they receive Jesus for the first time.

PSR is our faith formation program for children who do not go to a Catholic School. PSR for both SRW and SJC will now be held at SRW. The program will be overseen by Anney Roach who now serves at the DRE (Director of Religious Education) at both SRW and SJC. She will be working with families to offer three options. We will offer traditional PSR on Sunday mornings, an online option, and a homeschool option. No matter which option you choose Anney will work closely with your family to make sure your children are being formed well in the faith. 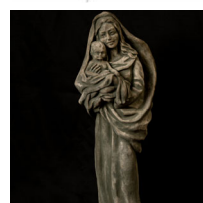
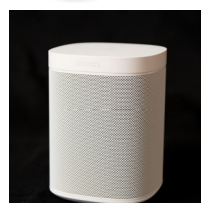
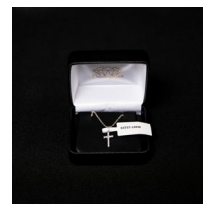
