WELCOME TO CATECHETICAL CORNER!

Christmas blessings! We celebrate once again that Christ has come...

into our world and into our lives.

As Catholics, of course, we experience the presence of Jesus at every Mass. He is present in the gathering of the faithful, as he promised us that "...where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them."

(Matthew 18:20). Christ is present, too, in the Scriptures, as he in fact is The Word spoken from the beginning of Creation, all through our salvation history, and especially in the New Testament. We even stand for the proclamation of the Gospel each week as we listen to The Word speak directly to us. Jesus is also present to us in the priest at every Mass; Father acts in persona Christi (in the person of Christ) each time he celebrates Mass, hears confessions, anoints the sick, etc. Notice at the moment of consecration how Father says, in first person, "This is my body..." This special role of his is why we respond to Father's "The Lord be with you" with "And with your spirit." The priest is more than just one more member of the faithful. He is Christ for us, presenting to us once more the offering of his sacrifice. Finally, of course, Jesus is present to us in that very sacrifice, the Eucharist, the bread and wine which have become his Body and Blood, his Soul and Divinity. Every time we receive Communion we take into ourselves the very person of Jesus, the second person of the Trinity. Like Mary, we carry him into the world to give him as a gift to others. May the Holy Family, whose feast we celebrate today, be our example, inspiring us to
