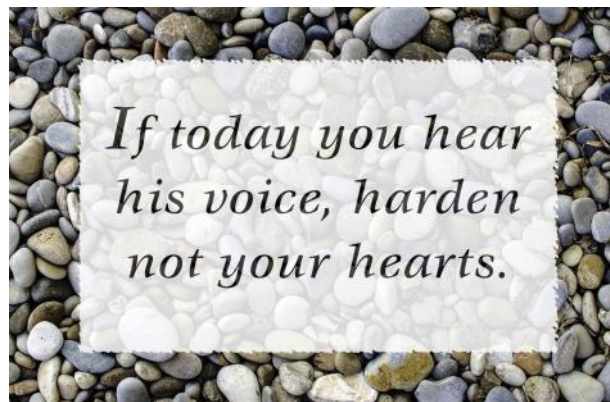

Changes for Mass during our extended cold and flu season

Effective immediately, For Mass:

- Please do not hold hands during the Our Father.
- Please do not shake hands during the Sign of Peace. Instead, clasp your hands together, make eye contact with those around you, and say "Peace be with you," or "Peace of Christ."
- If you are feeling sick, please receive Holy Communion in the hand, rather than on the tongue, and refrain from receiving Communion from the cup.
- Stay home when you are sick, your Sunday obligation is waived. Please join us in spirit by watching the 10 a.m. televised Mass from the Cathedral of Saint Andrew, on Fox 17.
- Hand sanitizer has been placed near all of the church entrances/exits.

In addition to these changes listed above, each of us has the responsibility of taking precautions to prevent the spread of illnesses by following these basic guidelines.

- Cover your mouth/nose with a tissue when coughing or sneezing.
- Wash hands frequently and for the appropriate length of time using soap and water, or hand sanitizing products.
- Avoid touching your face with unwashed hands
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.

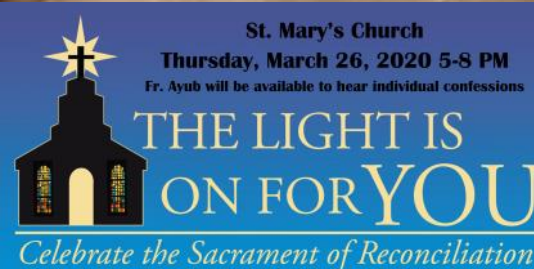
