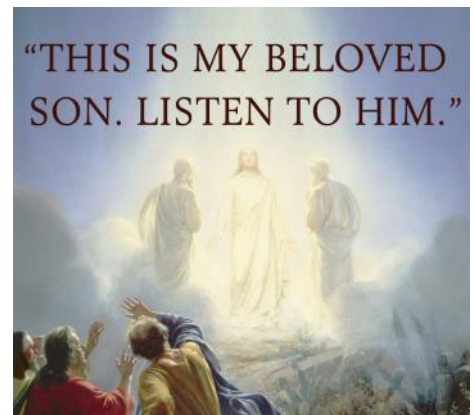

### Religious Education - COVID-19 UPDATES

Effective immediately, Bishop Walkowiak will allow K-12 faith formation classes to resume in-person. This decision comes after consultation with diocesan leaders.

**Classes resume Wednesday, February 24<sup>th</sup>**

**6:15-7:30. 6:15 - 8pm for the Confirmation class.**

If you registered for **in person learning** we look forward to seeing you. In home learning will continue online with contact from teacher and hybrid. We will arrange the time when your child will come in class (once a month or so). I am in the process of arranging the classroom so we can all meet together and will eliminate Group A and B. I am focusing on:

- In home screening
- Social distancing and forward facing seating
- PPE use / Masks
- Hygiene handwashing and hand sanitizing frequently
- Sanitation/Cleaning each child will have their own supplies they bring and take home
- Symptoms during class

Please watch for an email with any updates or changes. Drop off will be as it was before we went to remote learning. Drop off, come through circle, drop child off at the door (if you need to see me come in only as far as my office with mask on) continue around parking lot and exit. Pick up, park in the lot and wait for the teachers to bring your children out to you. Stay in your cars or stand by them. You may walk up as far as the first row of parked cars so we have a better chance to see you. We are trying to eliminate too much contact with in the building.
