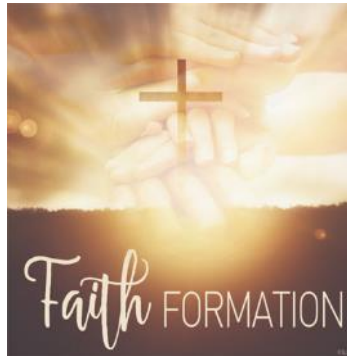
### Children's Liturgy of the Word—
