Laptops for 8th Graders

In 2015, the Nativity Technology Committee submitted a grant proposal to the James P. Scott Capital Improvement Endowment Fund maintained by the Catholic Community Foundation – Archdiocese of Indianapolis. The goal of the grant request was to expand the use of technology capabilities to Nativity's middle school students beginning with our eighth grade class of 2016. In order to purchase the laptops, charging cart, and upgrading our infrastructure to accommodate the additional wireless accesses, we requested \$55,000 as part of our proposal.

We were overjoyed to receive notification that we received \$27,750 (one half of the amount needed) from the James P. Scott Award to begin this process. In order to make this dream come to fruition, the school matched the grant amount and the computers were purchased and the infrastructure upgraded.

Last Friday, each member of the Nativity Class of 2018 was presented with his/her own computer to use throughout the school day.
