21st Century Scholars Program

Dear 7th and 8th Grade Parents.


If you are not aware, the State of Indiana has the 21st Century Scholars Program. The Scholars program provides **income-eligible students** the opportunity to earn a scholarship that **covers up to**

colleges/universities. It may seem to be far away, but if you qualify, then you may enroll between the start of 7th grade through June 30th after 8th grade. For any family who has not applied yet, we highly recommend you review the attached documents to see if you qualify and, if so, then apply. If you are unsure if you have applied or not, you can check in ScholarTrack, the online system referenced in the documents.

You can also find the income guidelines in the attached document. You can learn more about the program and resources and college at https://learnmoreindiana.org/scholars/enroll/ Again, June 30 after your student's 8th grade year is the deadline to apply.
