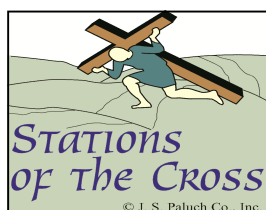
Parish Family Stations of the Cross

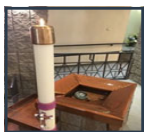

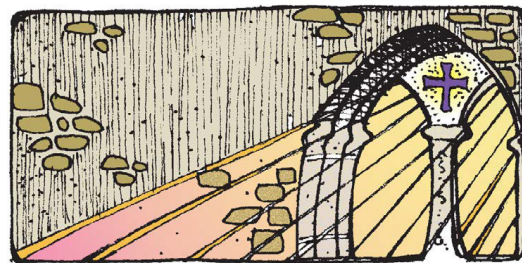

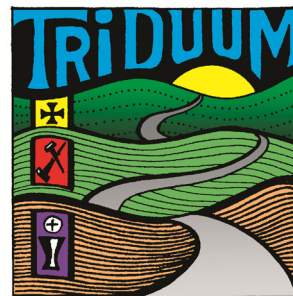
