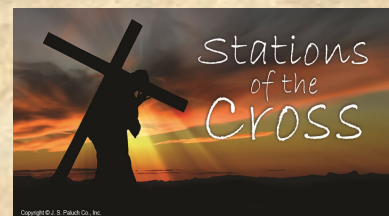

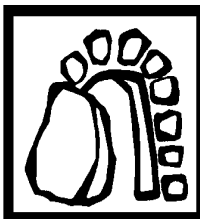


Blessing of the Easter Food

Visitation of the Tomb

Good Friday begins the vigil at symbolic tombs of Christ built at churches throughout the world and lasts until Holy Saturday. Adoration of the Good Friday tombs is called "the visitation of the tombs." The observation of a period of silence at home for devotional reading and private prayer between the hours of noon and 3:00 p.m. is often practiced. The opportunity to visit, privately reflect, and pray at The Tomb of Christ will be available on Friday, April 19 from 8:00 a.m. - 10:00 p.m. and Saturday, April 20, from 6:30 a.m. - 6:00 p.m., in the old chapel (Rm. 1). All are welcome to come and pray in silence. Fresh cut and/or potted flowers are also welcomed for the tomb.

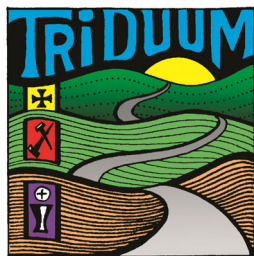
Holy Spirit Blood Drive

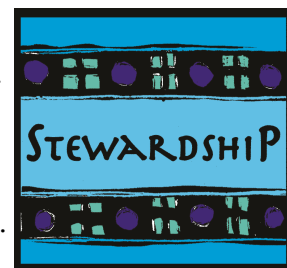
