Finance Council Report

Our parish Finance Council would like to bring a concern to your attention that was brought forth in May of this year. The Parish ended its most recent fiscal year with a deficit of approximately \$145,000. Our hope was that our most recent quarter ended September 30, 2019, would show a reversal of this negative revenues and net income trend. Unfortunately, for the quarter ended September 30, 2019, our Parish is experiencing a \$24,000 negative plate income variance. The cause of this continues to be directly related to a drop in weekly plate donations and not a result of our attending Community. Our weekly donations directly fund the operations of our Parish Community. The Finance Council and our Parish leadership made significant budget cuts to address these losses for the Fiscal Year 2020. However, these losses have continued. We will continue to proactively develop a plan to bring our Parish out of its current trend. In the coming months we will continue to communicate our efforts and plan to our faith Community. Our hope is that our Community will pray and reflect on our shared commitment and support for our Community. We ask that we all remain committed and consistent with our plate donations and if possible to increase our donations, any increase would make a difference.

Rosary Makers Ministry

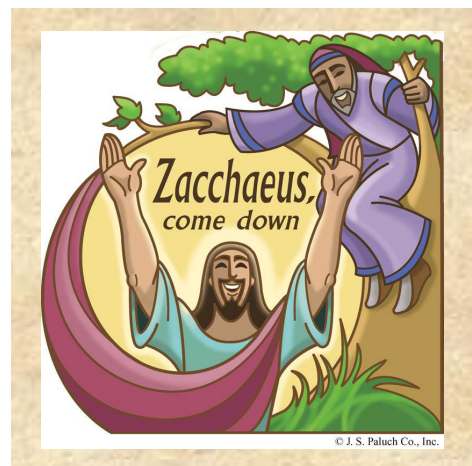

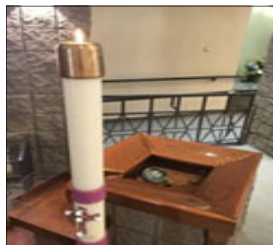
TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Every week, some treasures from our tradition are shared here. Where does all this history come from? The history of God's people of prayer is always coming to light, mostly because scholars have dedicated their lives to research. They translate and ponder prayers and songs; explore the places used for worship; look at the vessels, books, and vestments; and read works from legal documents to letters and diaries. In the 1930s, Hitler's rush to arm Germany closed seminaries as priests and seminarians alike were drafted into service.

One professor, Father Josef Jungman, forced from his classroom, spent the war years in an Austrian library. His careful work disclosed much of what we know of the history of the Mass. His great work, *The Mass of the Roman Rite*, describes the evolution of Eucharistic celebration and inspired generations of scholars to explore a tradition surprisingly rich and varied. It was said of him that he had a command of the past that cast new light on the present, and opened up a clear direction to the future. His contributions to the Second Vatican Council helped shape the way that we worship today. At the end of his life, in 1975, his studies completed, he told a friend that he was waiting patiently for the Lord's knock at the door to take him to the heavenly banquet.

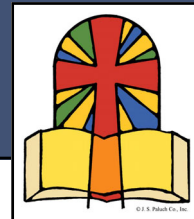

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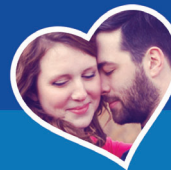
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Around the Diocese
