AN IMPORTANT REMINDER FROM FR. JOHN

PROPER RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION



Catholics believe that the bread and wine on the altar become truly the Body and Blood of Jesus, not merely bread and wine any longer. We approach the Eucharist with great reverence and awe. Catholics receiving Holy Communion fast from food for at least one hour prior and are not conscious of any unconfessed, grave sin.

If you are not Catholic or for some other reason do not wish to receive holy communion you are invited to make a "spiritual" communion through a silent interior desire for communion with Jesus Christ. To receive a blessing, enter the communion line and simply present yourself to the priest or deacon with your arms folded across your chest.





Should you choose to receive communion in the hand, you <u>must</u> immediately consume the sacred host in front of the priest or minister. It is <u>not</u> permissible to walk away with the host in your hand.

A communicant may choose whether to receive the Holy Eucharist in the hand or on the tongue. Communion is administered with the words, "The Body of Christ." After the communicant has responded "Amen" the consecrated host is then placed in the hand or on the tongue according to the manner indicated by the communicant.

Communion is received in the hand. If one is right handed then the left hand should rest upon the right. The host will then be laid in the palm of the left hand and then taken by the right hand to the mouth. If one is left-handed this is reversed.


