Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Women hold an important role throughout the scriptures and have a unique role in the salvation history. This week's Gospel account of Martha and Mary illustrates the important role of women in discipleship. Hospitality to visitors and proclaiming the truth of God from their hearing, allows us all to be witnesses to the action of salvation story. As we witness these women being attentive to the needs of Jesus, we are all called to work on our own way in which we are called to hospitality and discipleship.

Next, there is an ongoing need for food items in our greater community. To assist a greater number of people in need of food, we are asking everyone to bring in donated food items on a regular basis for the St. Vincent De Paul food pantry. The SVD food pantry is always in need of nutritious nonperishable items such as peanut butter, tuna, canned meats, vegetables, pasta, pasta sauce, canned fruit, rice, beans and shelf stable milk. The SVD collection box is located in the narthex of the Church. Thank you for your great generosity.

One of our parish goals in 2022 is to increase the number of families supporting St Hyacinth using electronic giving. Currently we have 211 families using electronic giving and Faith Direct. You can register by logging on at sthyacinth.org or directly to <https://sthyacinth.org/online-giving> and give electronically online.

However, I do want to address the approximately the over 1044 registered families here at STHY that we have no record of your giving to the Church. We do acknowledge that many are giving to the Church through the weekend collection; however, STHY needs you start moving toward electronic giving. In this way we can account for all those who are a part of the parish that are truly giving, and it is an expense of the church for envelopes to be mailed to registered families. We currently spend close to \$10K a year on offertory envelopes and if we could use our electronic giving, this would reduce the expense of mailed offertory envelopes dramatically.

This year we will celebrate the 57th anniversary of the founding of St Hyacinth. For this year's celebration, the weekend of August 20th - 21st. there will be a time of prayer, remembrance, and celebration. There will be giveaways and fun throughout the weekend culminating with the raffle of wonderful prizes. So, please mark your calendars for this wonderful celebration .

For the parish anniversary, we will have a silent auction. We are in need of gift cards for the various gift baskets that will be auctioned off. I am asking everyone if they could donate a \$25- \$50 gift card from their favorite store so that we can add them to the gift baskets that will go up for auction. Thank you for your generosity in helping us celebrate our parish anniversary. Just place the gift cards in the regular collection basket when you attend mass on Sunday.

For our parish anniversary, we have begun collecting funds for a Statue of St. Hyacinth. We should have a representation of our patron saint in our Church, and we are the only Catholic Church named after St. Hyacinth in the United States that does not have a statue of our patron saint. A four-foot custom-made linden wood and painted statue of St. Hyacinth will cost approximately \$18K. (The handmade statue would have St. Hyacinth holding a monstrance and a little statue of a Madonna with Child). We have placed a special donation box in the Narthex as well as a picture of the statue. You can give online at <https://sthyacinth.org/statue-of-st-hyacinth> as well. Thank you for your support in precuring a statue for our Church.

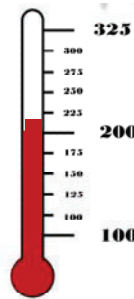
