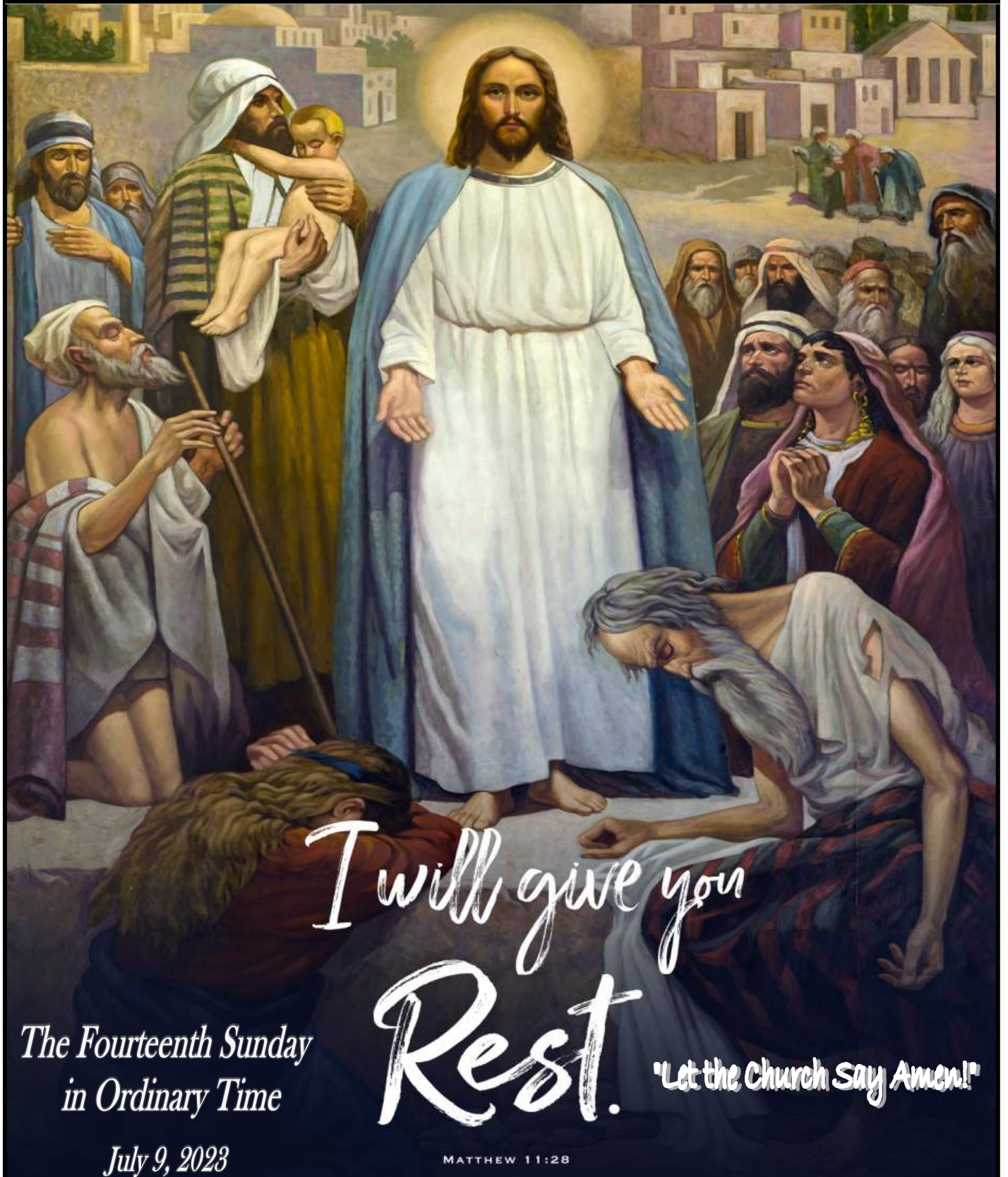

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ

Jesus praises God for revealing his teachings to the humble and the lowly, rather than the wise and learned. He then invites all those who are weary and burdened to come to him for rest. He promises that his yoke is easy, and his burden is light.

What is the yoke Jesus offers in our Gospel this week? Jesus invites the weary to learn from him, for He is not a tyrant who lords it over his disciples but is “gentle and humble in heart.”

The yoke that Jesus refers to in the gospel was a familiar symbol of burden bearing, oppression, and subjugation. Yokes were laid on the necks and shoulders of oxen and on prisoners of war. Yet, Jesus uses the word “yoke” metaphorically with positive connotations, as in the invitation to wisdom and as a rabbinic metaphor for the difficult but joyous task of obedience to God.

Next, mark your calendar for August 19-20, 2023, for the celebration of the 58th anniversary of our parish. Planning has already begun for the celebration of our parish with food, fun and prizes. We will have further details as the weeks go by on how we can make the celebrations of our parish a wonderful event for the church and community.

Preparation has begun for the Archdiocesan Youth Conference (AYC) which gathers participants from all over the local Church. AYC is the largest evangelizing event for older adolescents that the Archdiocese hosts annually. The youth conference will be held at the Hilton Americas Hotel on July 28-30, 2023. 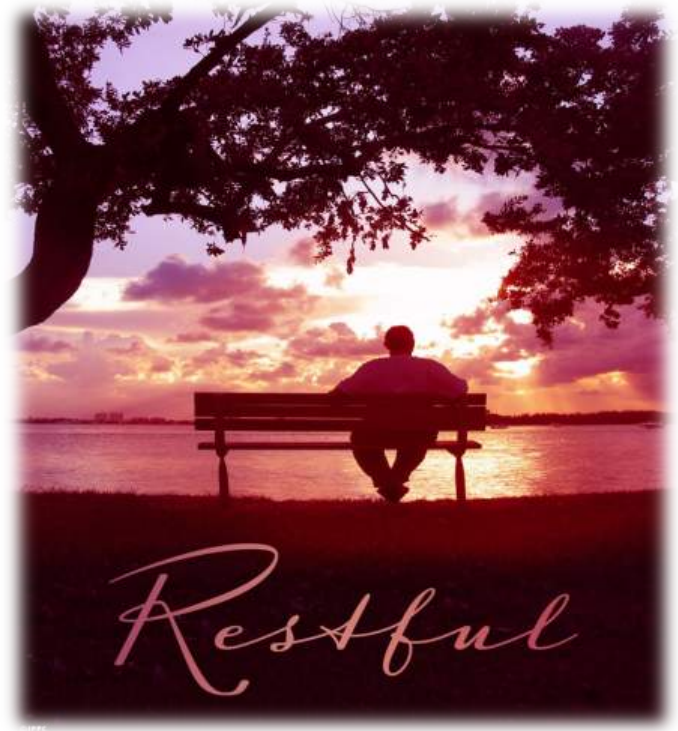

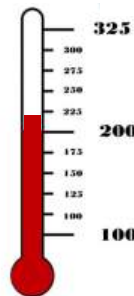

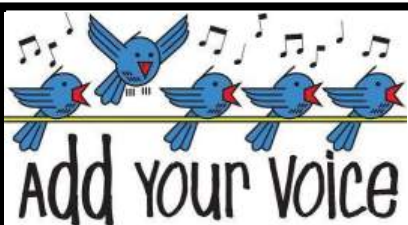
