Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

"Grant your faithful, we pray almighty God, the resolve to run forth to meet your Christ with righteous deeds at his coming....." with these words we begin our Advent walk with God and the new liturgical time is set. 



Stained Glass Renovation Project to Protect and Secure


