

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Lent is a special time of the Church year in which we all deny self so that we may be better to give ourselves to others. Yet, our Lenten practices must go beyond self-denial to renewing our relationship with God. We are called to reflect on this season how we can be better, do better and increase our faith.

In this Sunday's Gospel we witness the glory of Jesus in the transfiguration and how this transformation foreshadows the glory to be given to all who remain faithful to him. We are pleasing to Jesus when we live as he did. We experience Jesus' presence in the goodness and kindness of others, in the community gathered for liturgy and prayer and are transformed by that love in which we share.

The glory of the transfiguration brings us all closer in our relationship with Jesus. ## Gospel

Mk 9:2-10

Jesus took Peter, James, and John and led them up a high mountain apart by themselves.

And he was transfigured before them, and his clothes became dazzling white, such as no fuller on earth could bleach them.

Then Elijah appeared to them along with Moses, and they were conversing with Jesus.

Then Peter said to Jesus in reply,

"Rabbi, it is good that we are here!

Let us make three tents:

one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." He hardly knew what to say, they were so terrified. Then a cloud came, casting a shadow over them; from the cloud came a voice.

"This is my beloved Son. Listen to him." Suddenly, looking around, they no longer saw anvone

but Jesus alone with them.

As they were coming down from the mountain, he charged them not to relate what they had seen to anyone,

except when the Son of Man had risen from the dead. So they kept the matter to themselves, questioning what rising from the dead meant.


