# GUIDELINES TO PARISHIONERS WHO ARE ATTENDING MASS

Thank you to all those who have registered at our parish website or have called the parish office for request to attend Mass. Please note the following:

- ➤ If you have not received a call from our volunteers yet, please wait for your turn in the next following weeks due to the high volume of requests.
- ➤ Only 50 parishioners are allowed at each Mass. This includes, those registered parishioners who signed up for this Mass, priests, altar server, lector, sacristan, choir, and those who are helping to prepare the church for reopening.
- The livestream of this Sunday's (June 14) 11:00am Mass will be broadcast via our parish YouTube Channel: <a href="www.youtube/icdeltaparish">www.youtube/icdeltaparish</a>
- Parishioners who have signed up for attending Mass on weekdays and Sundays, please pick up the orange card before you enter the Church and leave it in your area for sanitization, as a marker for post Mass sanitization of the pew.
- ➤ Please bring your own hand sanitizer and mask with you to church.
- ➤ We encourage parishioners to receive the Holy Communion by hand. However, respecting the right of those faithful who wish to receive Holy Communion on the tongue, they should come forward after all other communicants have received.
- ➤ All those attending Mass may do so at their own risk. It is important for individuals and families to take responsibility for protecting themselves and others.
- ➤ The following must stay home for the sake of the wider community:
  - People with COVID-19 or who live with someone with COVID-19.
  - People who have been exposed to someone with COVID-19.
  - The sick, including those with even the slightest symptoms or feelings of sickness, especially if with upper respiratory or flulike symptoms.
  - Those who have recently travelled outside of Canada.
- > The following are encouraged to stay home for the sake of the wider community:
  - People who live with someone with upper respiratory or flu-like symptoms.
  - People, especially the elderly, with underlying or comprised medical conditions.
  - Family members who live with elderly people or those who are at risk.
