

Dear IC Delta Family,

My name is Miguel Galvez and I recently just got hired to work as a full-time missionary with Catholic Christian Outreach (CCO). You may have seen me helping out at our parish through playing music with the choir for the 4pm mass, and helping out with some adoration events we've had in the past. Unfortunately, I will be leaving our amazing parish as I will be moving to Halifax, Nova Scotia in September for the mission.

The purpose of CCO is very simple: In Canada, 79% of Catholics will leave the church by age 23. I know for myself how painful it can be to watch family and friends leave the Church that they grew up in, and I'm sure many of you present today can empathise.

This is a huge problem.

CCO exists to go onto university campuses to reach out to those students, particularly those who've left the church, and BRING - THEM - BACK! We create opportunities for students to encounter Jesus, and then build them up into leaders for the renewal of our church and the whole world.

This past school year, CCO had over 5700 students involved across Canada, many of whom were not previously practicing their faith. I personally had the privilege to journey intentionally with some of these students who came back home to the Church, and journeyed with them through RCIA to them receiving their first sacraments. On our campuses, literally hundreds of young people have committed to sharing their faith with their families and friends.

With what I've witnessed, I am filled with tremendous hope.

In order to move and be able to share the gospel with the university students in Halifax, I need your help. I need to grow my team of supporters who will be helping me with their prayers and financial contributions so that I can reach them with the gospel. I'd love to share with you more about my ministry with a brief presentation in the next week or so, and I hope that you can get in touch with me.
