You can attend St. Nicholas School for FREE The new Choice Scholarship law that passed in June 2023 will now allow most students to attend St. Nicholas School for free. The scholarship uses the tax money that you already pay to the public school and redirects it to the school of your choice. Choice Scholarship covers **all** books, fees, and tuition. The only requirements are that your student be an Indiana resident and be 5 by September 1, 2023. There are no longer any pathways necessary.
