The 17th Sunday in Ordinary Time. A common thread through all three readings is the contrast between divine generosity and human persistence. Abraham persists in his negotiation, gradually reducing the number needed to save Sodom. Jesus teaches that we should "ask...seek...knock" with persistence. Yet both passages ultimately emphasize God's exceeding generosity—God is willing to spare an entire city for the sake of a few righteous people, and gives the Holy Spirit to those who ask.
