October is Bullying Prevention Month

The current definition acknowledges two modes and four types by which youth can be bullied or can bully others. The two modes of bullying include **direct** (e.g., bullying that occurs in the presence of a targeted youth) and **indirect** (e.g., bullying not directly communicated to a targeted youth such as spreading rumors). In addition to these two modes, the four types of bullying include broad categories of physical, verbal, relational (e.g., efforts to harm the reputation or relationships of the targeted youth), and damage to property.

Bullying affects all youth, including those who are bullied, those who bully others, and those who see bullying going on.

Totus Tuus is a weeklong summer Catholic youth program dedicated to sharing the Gospel and promoting the Catholic Faith through catechesis, Christian witness and Eucharistic worship.

It is led by young adult missionaries.

The methodology, structure, content, and enthusiasm of Totus Tuus is concerned with not only teaching the Faith, but also igniting the hearts of the team members and the young people they encounter.

There is a program for K through 6th grade in the morning and a program for Middle and High School in the evening.

This summer six parishes experienced Totus Tuus: St. Dominic/Our Lady of the Rosary, St. Peter, St. Paul, St. Rita, Cathedral of the Sacred Heart, St. Ann, GB.

> Topics next summer are: The Mystery of Salvation and the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary

We are currently deciding what changes we as a diocese would like to make including extending to Pre-K and increasing the activities as well as Changing parts of the evening program.

We definitely will be looking for young adults from our diocese to be the missionaries.
