The director of Music's primary responsibility is to plan and conduct music programs in support of religious services, parish. He/she is to function as an accompanist and ensure appropriate weekend coverage for masses. Work schedule shall be set in consultation with the Pastor.

- 2. Receive approval of the Pastor for any expenses of the music program beyond approved budget
- 3. Supervise maintenance of equipment, i.e., pianos, keyboards, and audio equipment, music library as determined by the Pastor
- 4. Knowledge of Microsoft Office® (Word, Excel, Power Point) or Apple® (Numbers, Pages, Keynote)

B. Music Program Development

- 1. Consult the Pastor in determining goals of the parish's overall music program
- 2. Provide music recommendations for religious services
- 3. Coordinate music programs with liturgical calendar
- 4. Keep informed of current music methods, materials, utilizing them where appropriate
- 5. Establish regular rehearsals when needed
- 6. Work with Cantors to develop skills and presentation
- 7. Regularly attend meetings of the parish regarding liturgy
- 8. Maintaining copyright licenses for all music used in Liturgies

C. Music Program Implementation

- 1. Direct planning and conducting of music programs within the church
- 2. Coordinate the performance schedules of music groups and individuals within the church
- 3. Expand and enhance the breadth and depth of range of music, using and ever-increasing number of genres of music employed for masses
- 4. Availability for funerals and weddings required

5. Coordinate coverage for all weekend masses at the parish
